

Forest County squads now equipped with cameras & laptops

The Forest County Sheriffs Department has added some high tech equipment to their marked squad cars. All of the marked squads are now equipped with a lap top computer mounted in the vehicle. The computers are loaded with the Badger Stop TraCS program.

Badger Stop gives the officer almost instant info on a stopped vehicle. By running the plate number into the computer, the officer will be told who is the owner of the vehicle and will run a database on that person. The data will be drawn and given to the Sheriff's Department, the Clerk of Courts computer as well as the DOT data base in Madison. If that individual has outstanding warrants or is dangerous, the officer will know immediately and can call for backup. The system will also print a citation.

Sheriff Dennee is happy to report that the system was paid for by a Department of Justice Grant and a donation from the Potawatomi Foundation for the sum of \$22,500, so there was no cost to the local taxpayers.

In addition, the marked squads have also been equipped with digital cameras that will record all traffic stops. This system, says Sheriff Dennee is a good thing for the deputies, as it records any activity by the suspect, but it is also a good thing for anybody stopped by an officer who might be more aggressive than necessary.

The cameras were paid for by the Potawatomi Foundation with a \$20,000 grant.



Erica Keller Advances to State



Wabeno forensics competitor, senior Erica Keller, worked long and hard to make her way to the state level of competition in high school forensics this spring. Coached by Mark Asleson, three students participated in senior high forensics this year: Erica Keller, Kate Lowery, and Kimberly Spreeman. Forensics is for students who enjoy acting, reading aloud, or participating in any type of play.

Erica Keller has participated in forensics for six years, beginning in junior high. To reach the state competition in Madison, Erica first needed to earn passing scores at the sub-district level in Crandon, and then district in Tomahawk. This year Erica selected prose, a category which involves reading a story or article up to eight minutes long. She chose a short monologue by Erma Bombeck, about traveling in foreign countries and dealing with different public restrooms. Each presentation was scored by judges utilizing a 25 point rubric for evaluation. At state Erica received a score of 24 out of 25 earning her a silver medal.

While the forensics team attended the two day competition in Madison, they enjoyed shopping, eating lots of Italian food, and trying to stay dry in the rain. College Goal Sunday

It's not too late for financial assistance!

College Goal Sunday (CGS) is a statewide charitable program that provides free information and assistance to families applying for college financial aid. In 2011 College Goal Sunday events took place at 30 sites around the state of Wisconsin, as well as, sites in 40 states and the District of Columbia. Throughout Wisconsin 2148 students and families received free assistance in completing their financial aid materials. Of these, 13% or 282 attended the Rhinelander site ~ the highest attended site in the state.

In addition to assistance in completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid, students and families were provided a light lunch, prize drawing, and \$550.00 in scholarships all donated. Local community support for this event is astounding and demonstrates to the students the value that is placed by their community on postsecondary education. Event organizers want to thank those who volunteered their time to help at the event, and the local businesses and organizations who donated for the prize drawing, lunch, or scholarships.

Presentations on the financial aid process and transitioning to college were provided by Bill Peshel, Nicolet Area Technical College Financial Aid Director and Joan Lefebvre, University of Wisconsin Extension Family Living Agent, respectively.

Students and families are asked to complete an online survey at the event. Of the families in attendance at the Rhinelander site 73% said they could not have completed, or not completed the FAFSA as well without the help College Goal Sunday provided and 88% felt it was worth the effort of attending. Volunteers assist families in the online completion of the FAFSA and the majority of respondents found this one-on-one help to be the most beneficial aspect of the event. While College Goal Sunday is open to anyone pursuing postsecondary education, the event was primarily attended by high school students with 96% of respondents currently enrolled in high school and 95% first time financial aid applicants. More than half of the students responding to the survey are planning to pursue a Bachelor's or higher level degree.

Couple charged with animal neglect in Crandon

Submitted by Daniel G. Packard, Jr., Chief of Police Crandon Police Department, May 10, 2011 Animal Abuse/Neglect

Following a number of tips and complaints, an investigation was begun in April 2011 by the Crandon Police Department (CPD) into the possibility of animal abuse/neglect taking place at 405 N. Lind Ave. in the City of Crandon. A search warrant was subsequently obtained from Forest County District Attorney Charles Simono and served on John W. Johnson and Jacqueline L. Johnson at that location.

Upon acting on the warrant and searching the property, officers from the CPD and the Forest County Sheriff's Department (assisted by Susie Sturzl of the Forest County Humane Society and Dr. Alison French, DVM, Rhinelander) discovered that there were 25 dogs—adults and puppies—most in poor health and being confined in appalling conditions. All the dogs were seized due to poor living conditions and visible mistreatment, which was corroborated by Dr. French, and were transported to the Forest County Humane Society to undergo evaluation and treatment.

John W. Johnson and Jacqueline L. Johnson have each been charged with Fourteen (14) Counts of Mistreating Animals—Intentional or Negligent Violation—PTAC, as a Party to a Crime; and Two (2) Counts of Providing Proper Food to Confined Animals—PTAC, as a Party to a Crime.

If convicted, each person may receive a fine of not more than \$10,000.00 (ten thousand dollars), or be imprisoned not more than nine (9) months, or both, for EACH count they are charged with.




