## Town of Lincoln works on feasibility study for new community building

The town of Lincoln building committee met last Tuesday, May 17th, to discuss the possibility of a new community building to replace the current building on County W.

Two representatives from Keller Construction, of Kaukana, attended the meeting to discuss their providing of a feasibility study to the committee at a later date. If hired, the firm would meet with the committee as often as necessary to determine the needs and the costs of any future building project. For a sum of \$1,500, a preliminary proposal guide would be provided to the committee that would help in the planning and to determine the cost of the building project.

The two representatives from Keller Construction were Kelly Clafin, a planner and cost analyzer; and Rob Lindstrom, an architect with the firm. In their presentation they pointed out that they do a great many municipal projects. What they are offering, if hired, is their expertise on municipal buildings, and for this fee, the committee could determine things like the square footage needed to fulfill the needs of the town, which would include the amount of office space necessary to handle town business, the size of the meeting area to handle town meetings as well as social events, type of construction, etc.

They defined two different types of construction methods. What they are offering is to fulfill the roll of "project manager." The other method is to hire an architectural firm to handle all phases of the building project. Under the project manager system, Keller would handle all aspects of the building project, and each facet of the project would be put out on bids. Keller would handle all of the bidding procedure, and the final selection of the bid winners would be determined by the building committee. The presenters pointed out that this could be good for local contractors. They said that if the building contract went to an architectural firm, the architect would likely hire whatever contractors that were frequently hired by the firm and that each phase of the project would not be bid. According to Clafin and Lindstrom, this could significantly add to the cost. This is called a "design bid."

If hired, Keller would provide a budget proposal for the project that would fit the needs of the town of Lincoln, as would be determined after more consultation with the building committee.

A decision to hire the firm was not made at Tuesday's meeting, but all present wanted to spend more time thinking about and discussing the issue.

In addition, Supervisor Larry Sommer presented a report on numerous other area community buildings in the area with information on the size of the facilities and the costs of construction in relation to the size of the community.

According to members of the committee, if it is decided to build a new community center for the town of Lincoln, and it is apparent that one is needed, the building would begin next year on land already owned by the town. The building committee is in the very beginning of the planning of the project, and the committee will be looking for public input in the months ahead.

## School District of Wabeno Area Hosts Two Cents Event

Mark your calendars and come join us! The next Two Cents Event will be on Tuesday, June 7, 2011 from 6:30pm-8:00pm at the high school in the auditorium.

In the past, the School District of Wabeno Area has held Two Cents Events not only to share information with the school communities, but also to get input from parents, students, community members and staff. Since the last event, much has happened at the state level in regard to school funding and budgets. It is important for us to get together to review the school district's financial status and to ask for your input about programming and priorities as we plan for the future.

While the legislators are still debating budgets and policies in Madison, our staff, administrators, and school board are working together to find ways to reduce spending and still maintain outstanding academic and extracurricular opportunities for our students. A few of the recent cost savings measures we will be implementing include changing health insurance carriers, having employees pay their contribution to the Wisconsin Retirement System, and having employees pay a higher percentage of the health insurance premiums. A substantial savings will be realized with these changes. However, these changes do not offer enough relief to completely offset the losses in revenue we will likely be facing for the 2011-2012 school year.

Of course, these more recent budget challenges are only complicating the school funding issue that has been festering for many years. At last year's Two Cents Event, we explained how the long-term effects of revenue limits and declining enrollment have been catching up with our district. We will review all of these issues, give updates, and seek your input at the next Two Cents Event on Tuesday, June 7.

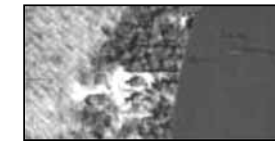

### Emergency Preparedness

#### An invitation to participate

In response to the October 2010 power outage, members of the Forest County Commission on Aging and Department of Social Services in conjunction with the Forest County Health Department have initiated an Emergency Preparedness Contact Registry Project for Seniors and persons with disabilities and/or special needs.

The contact registry will provide basic and special needs information regarding participating individuals to emergency responders in emergent situations such as flood, tornado, blizzard, power outage, disease outbreak or other disaster. The information will be used to insure the safety of individuals and assist with special needs as conditions allow.

The registry is voluntary and in no way insures that registrants will receive immediate or preferential treatment. It will not replace a personal emergency preparedness plan.

The registry will help us identify, by Township, individuals to emergency responders and establish a net work for the dissemination of information in regard to emergency services, such as warming shelters and personal preparedness information.

If you would like to place your name and basic information on the registry, contact, Janet Weber, CSW, at the Forest County Department of Social Services. Janet is the registry coordinator. She will be contacting you by phone to verify the information provided and to discuss any special needs (oxygen, hearing, sight, mobility or other physical impairments, seizures, etc.) that you might have.

**Sunlight for good health!**  
The sun helps us make vitamin D, the sunshine

vitamin, which is essential for healthy teeth and bones, heart health and better immunity. Recent studies show vitamin D may help reduce risk for certain cancers.

Very little sun exposure is needed to stimulate production of vitamin D: 10-15 minutes twice a week to the face, arms, legs or back without sunscreen is usually enough. Infants and sun-sensitive folks, however, need to stay out of direct sunlight.

After your sun time is up, apply a sunscreen with an SPF of 15 or more to prevent sun damage. Accumulation of sun exposure over years can accelerate visible skin aging and lead to skin cancer.

The best source of vitamin D is food: milk, soy milk, orange juice, and some ready-to-eat cereals. Vitamin D supplements are an option to discuss with your provider.

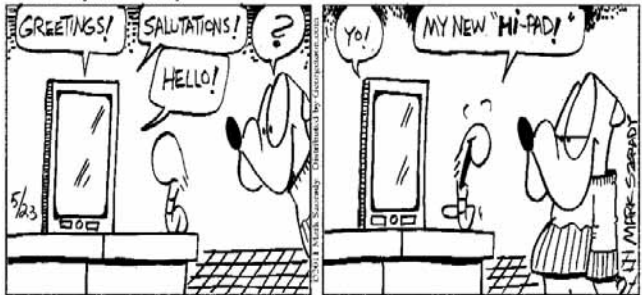

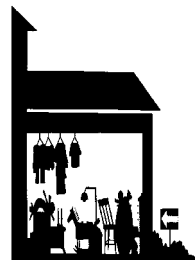

Projects funded include, Green Bay Sport Show, attendees to the Governor's Tourism Conference, Discover Wisconsin ATV Episode, Discover Wisconsin Mole Lake Episode, and the 2010 Forest County Visitor Guide.

Last year's big project, the acquisition and development of the Forest County Visitor Center, continues to receive positive feedback from throughout the region. This professional, attractive setting is very welcoming and visible to those who visit the area. It also provides a central meeting location that is highly utilized by several county groups.

The commission expects promoting the area through room tax dollars will continue to produce a significant impact on bringing additional tourism dollars to the area. The commission will continue working with advertising executive Gary Mueller throughout the year on several exciting new projects to help make Forest County a tourism destination.

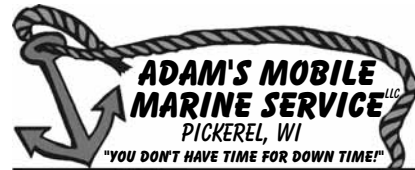

**Pickerel Volunteer Fire And Rescue Why We Do What We Do**

Welcome to our third informational article in an ongoing series. Instead of questions to answer from you, we have a couple of informational tidbits to share with everyone this month.

May is Stroke Awareness Month.

Below are some of the signs and symptoms of stroke. If you notice any of these, this is a true emergency where every minute counts.

So "act F.A.S.T."

**F**ace == Does one side droop? Ask the person to smile to test for a facial drop.

**A**rms == Is one arm weak or numb? Ask the person to raise both arms. Does one arm drift downward?

**S**peech == Is speech slurred? Ask the person to repeat a simple sentence. Is the sentence repeated correctly?

**T**ime == If the person has any of these symptoms, CALL 911 or get to the hospital immediately.

Others symptoms can be trouble walking, trouble seeing, having a hard time forming thoughts, headaches.

Q: What causes a stroke?

A: A stroke happens when the blood supply to part of the brain is interrupted or severely reduced. This deprives the brain tissue of oxygen and food. Within minutes, brain cells begin to die.

Q: What test do they do to confirm a stroke?

A: The test they do at the hospital is called a Cat Scan (CT for short) and is done in radiology. With this they can see where the interruption to the blood supply in the brain is.

Q: Why the need to act fast?

A: The sooner you get help the less damage is done. Early action can minimize damage and complications. There are medications and/or surgical interventions that can be used to help but they need happen in a timely fashion in connection with the start of symptoms.

Spring is finally here and with the nice weather some organizations take on the large job of cleaning up the roadsides and ditches. Whether you are an adult organization, a school group, or a single person just wanting to be helpful, there are things you should be aware of when cleaning up the country side. Always wear gloves!! For no other reason than the bottles, cans, glasses and waste you find have other peoples germs on them and the phrase "You don't know where that stuff has been!" comes to mind. Some germs can live a long time, so don't take chances and protect yourself. Also in our beautiful north woods there has been a recent increase in the discovery of secret methamphetamine laboratories and related dump sites. Certain trash you may find in the ditches that may relate to this are, empty lye cans, plastic bottles with tubing attached, empty camping fuel cans, broken lithium batteries and soda bottles with fluid in them not resembling any soda you have ever seen. One of these items alone does not necessarily represent meth activity, but several items in a close location could indicate criminal activity. NEVER OPEN AND DUMP OUT A BOTTLE WITH LIQUID IN, ESPECIALLY IF THE CONTENTS SEEM UNDER PRESSURE. Do not be afraid to contact your local law enforcement

**VA Processing Hundreds of Applications for New Family Caregiver Benefits in First Week**  
 WASHINGTON In the first week for open applications, the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) has assisted more than 625 Veterans, Servicemembers and their Family Caregivers in applying for new services under the Caregivers and Veterans Omnibus Health Services Act 2010.  
 "We are off to a good start having helped hundreds to apply, but we know there are thousands more who will qualify and need to apply today," said Secretary of Veterans Affairs Eric K. Shinseki. "I encourage eligible Veterans and their Family Caregivers to apply now to receive the benefits they have earned."  
 New services for primary Family Caregivers of eligible post-9/11 Veterans include a stipend, mental health services, and access to health care insurance, if they are not already entitled to care or services under a health plan. The stipend portion of this service will be backdated to the date of the application. Comprehensive Caregiver training and medical support are other key components of this program.

VA began processing applications for eligible post-9/11 Veterans and Servicemembers to designate a Primary Family Caregiver on May 9, 2011. On top of receiving the 625 plus applications, Caregiver Support Coordinators have also assisted nearly 1,200 other Caregivers in finding more than two dozen other Caregiver benefits VA provides.  
 Applications can be processed by telephone through the Caregiver Support Line at (855) 260-3274, in person at a VA medical Center with a Caregiver Support Coordinator, by mail or online at www.caregiver.va.gov with the new Caregiver Application (VA Form 1010-CG). The website application also features a chat option that provides the Family Caregiver with a live representative to assist in completing the application form.

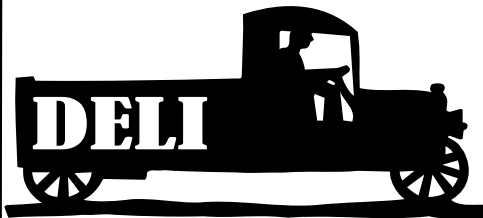

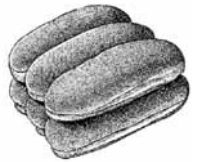
