The price is \$29.95 for up to 200 smokes, and with the Grand Opening special, you can take \$2 off the price. The Grand Opening price is good from Saturday, June 4th through Saturday, June 11th.

When you stop in, you pick the tobacco of your choice. Herb says they sell premium, U.S. tobacco with no additives. You will find that your smoke won't go out when you set it down. Still Smoking carries five distinctive bulk tobaccos which include two Turkish blends. You can also choose from nine selections of tubes.

Don't worry about using the rolling machine. Herb, Matthew, Lisa, Wilma or Brady will show you how to use the machine to make your own customized smokes.

Still Smoking also carries a selection of cigars, chewing tobacco, auto accessories, audio accessories and other miscellaneous merchandise.

In addition, the first 50 customers will receive a drink chip to one of Crandon's favorite bars.

## Holt & Balcom Museum to offer 2 programs this summer

The Holt and Balcom Logging Camp Museum in Lakewood will host two very special programs this summer, even though the Museum is closed for major renovation. On June 25 you are cordially invited to attend My Life as a Lumberjack starring Bill Kamke as John Nelligan. There will be two shows in the immediately adjacent McCauslin Golf Course and Country Club Clubhouse Dining Room, one at 2:00 p.m. and a repeat at 7:00 p.m.

Bill's hour-long presentation will be casual, interactive, and highly informative as he interprets the life of John Nelligan, from his birth in New Brunswick in 1852 to his life as a lumberjack in the Oconto area where he came in 1872. Bill's appearance includes a display of artifacts that he has collected over the years including a Big Pine Era timeline. This program is ideal family educational entertainment, suitable for all ages.

Bill begins his program with the history of the logging industry from coast to coast and its connection to Europe. He then turns his attention to how lumberjacks lived, their duties, the hardships they endured, the tools they used, what they ate, what they wore, and the funny camp stories that kept them amused. He ends by passing around various tools to see if the audience can guess what they were used for.

Then on July 23 the Holt and Balcom Logging Camp Museum will present Forest Fires: Then and Now by Gary Zimmer, a retired Forest Service Firefighting Team Leader. This lecture, also to be held in the Club Clubhouse Dining Room, will begin at 1:00 p.m.

It almost rained, but it didn't, and area Memorial Day ceremonies went as scheduled, but, unfortunately, the events were lightly attended.

The Laona VFW started their observance in Newald, moved to the Cavour Cemetery, and finished with a parade and a ceremony in the Laona Cemetery.

In each location the opening prayer was led by Dennis Mannering, Pastor of the Presbyterian Church. Lynn Liesch was the master of ceremonies. The Laona band provided music, including the National Anthem, and all of the various theme songs that represent the branches of the armed services, with the proper flag for each branch presented by the band's flag bearers.

Kimberly Mentz presented a speech in each community called "1868 Declaration Day." Her speech about veterans was followed by a salute by the VFW firing squad and the playing of "Taps." A memorial wreath was laid at all locations.

In Laona, the Laona High Band and veterans held a parade through town, then moved to the cemetery. 35th Assembly District Representative Tom Tiffany presented a speech. Tiffany reminded us that liberty is far more than freedom, it is also responsibility for our actions. Tiffany said that the founding fathers knew that we must have both liberty and responsibility.

#### Forest County Potawatomi Community Reaffirm Annual Agreements with Wabeno and United Area Rescue Squad

Crandon, Wis: The Forest County Potawatomi Community has reaffirmed longstanding partnerships with the United Area Rescue Squad and the Town of Wabeno. The two entities received \$21,218.00 and \$22,619.45 respectively to ensure rescue and fire protection services for all those living and working on tribal lands.

"We are pleased to partner with the Town of Wabeno Fire Service and the United Area Rescue Squad again this year," said Forest County Potawatomi Chairman Gus Frank. "Revenues from Indian gaming have made make it possible to support these services, which benefit our members and the Wabeno region as a whole."

"The United Area Rescue Squad has a strong

"The United Area Rescue Squad has a strong working relationship with the Forest County Potawatomi Community," said Jeff Hersh, Chief of the United Area Rescue Squad. "These monies will go toward the purchase of medical equipment as well as operating costs, which will greatly improve the quality of service we are able to provide."

"The renewal of our agreement with the Forest County Potawatomi is another example of the positive government to government relationship that both parties benefit from," said Town of Wabeno Chair Edward Piontek. The agreements, which total \$43,837.45, come after the tribe awarded \$95,000 to the Crandon School District for the Virtual Desktop Project in March and \$265,000 in grant monies to the school districts of Laona and Wabeno, the Community Coalition of Forest County, the Forest County Aging & Disability Resource Center, Forest County Commission on Aging, the Wabeno Sanitary District and the Town of Laona in January.

The tribe is the largest employer in Forest County, providing approximately 800 jobs to area residents through tribal government, the Tribe's health center, its Carter hotel and casino, and other businesses.

### Public invited to attend Resource Advisory Committee meeting

RHINELANDER, Wis. (May 26, 2011 ) -- Members of the community are invited to attend the Chequamegon-Nicolet National Forest's (CNNF) Resource Advisory Committees (RAC) meeting June 22 in Crandon, Wis.

The RACs are a way for local communities to work with Forest Service managers in recommending projects on federal lands, or projects that will benefit resources on federal lands using Title II funds. Title II funds under the reauthorized Secure Rural Schools and Community Self-Determination Act (Public Law 110-343) are made available to the RACs by counties receiving federal funds based on the percentage of land in federal ownership, timber receipt payments and per capita income.

The Nicolet RAC funds are available for the Eastside of the CNNF.

The meeting takes place June 22, 2011 at 9:30 a.m. in the Forest County Courthouse, County Boardroom, 200 East Madison St., Crandon, Wis.

During the meetings, committee members will review and recommend project proposal submissions for Title II projects. Projects can include restoring and maintaining watersheds; maintaining or obliterating roads, trails, or other infrastructure, controlling noxious and exotic weeds and reestablishing native species. Projects can also include improving soil productivity; restoring, maintaining and improving wildlife and fish habitat, and other improvements to forest ecosystem health. Projects must be located on Forest Service lands, Continued on pg 10





#### Crandon Summer School program

The School District of Crandon offers a voluntary summer school program to high school students who need to make up failed courses and/or finish courses marked as incomplete due to major excused extended absence. Additionally, athletes can use summer school as an opportunity to regain eligibility for fall sports. Certain requirements must be met for students to gain

Incomplete courses will require completion of outstanding work. When work has been satisfactorily completed, credit will be given and the student will no longer be required to attend class.

A course failed in both quarters of a semester requires the student complete satisfactory work and attend for 90 hours over the 30 day duration of summer school. Any missed time must be made up. The student will receive credit for each quarter and the semester. Only one semester can be made up with this option.

A course failed in one quarter of a semester and resulting in a semester failure requires the student complete satisfactory work and attends for 45 hours over the thirty day duration of summer school. Again, any time missed must be made up. The student will receive credit for that quarter and semester. It is possible to make up work for two semesters with this option.

Summer School Hours are: 7:30-8:30 Teacher Preparation; 8:30-10:00 First Session; 10:00-11:30 Second Session

Classes Start on Wednesday, June 15th.

Some students may need time off for emergencies, family events, or activity related camps. Teacher preparation time can be used to make up any class time missed due to absence or tardiness. Attendance records will be carefully maintained.

In summary, each student (except those with incomplete grades) must fulfill two basic requirements. These requirements include satisfactory completion of work and attendance. Should poor attendance lead to there not being enough class days to meet hourly requirements, the student will be dropped from the program and no credit awarded. Regular attendance is absolutely necessary.

To the editor: On Friday, May 20th, County Zoning Administrator Pam LaBine invited "all interested landowners" to attend the first of (4) sessions on the new shoreland zoning ordinance that will be crafted by Forest County in response to the DNR's re-writing of NR115. NR115 is a Department of Natural Resources statute whose purpose is to "promote the public health, safety and general welfare by adopting zoning regulations for the protection of all shoreland in unincorporated areas". Under the state's Public Trust Doctrine Wisconsin lakes and rivers are public resources, owned in common by all Wisconsin citizens. Based on the state constitution, this doctrine has been further defined by case law and statute It declares that all navigable waters are "common highways and forever free", and held in trust by the Department of Natural Resources.

During this meeting, Ms. Labine recommended a 'volunteer' work group be established to evaluate the rewriting of NR115 and make an official recommendation(s) to Forest County officials for changes in the shoreland zoning ordinance. Although counties have the flexibility to apply more stringent standards to NR115, Ms. Labine made it clear that the county's intent was to adopt minimal standards. When I volunteered to participate on the work group, I informed Ms. Labine that I am a past member of the City of Franklin Environmental Committee and had experience with NR115 zoning requirements. Ms. Labine said "I prefer professionals be on this work group - like lawyers and landscape designers"

I would like to remind Ms. Labine that like other citizens of Forest County, my taxes help pay her salary. I have the right to participate in the process that defines how the public's water resources will be protected. As a past member of the DNR - appointed Root River Partnership Team which was a diverse group of area business owners, private land owners and conservation groups - and included major players like South Eastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission, I know how to work with people to find a 'middle ground' that is acceptable to all and in the best interest of the general public. I suggest Ms. Labine rethink her strategy and include us taxpaying citizens in her work group. As Ms. Labine stated, it's a much easier process (and costs the county less) if people work together instead of everyone wanting to sue one another - to make their point. Linda Sturnot

#### **Holperin Co-Sponsors Rural Jobs Bill**

A reduced tax obligation for dairy, meat and food processing facilities would be the main incentive for those businesses to invest in plant upgrades under legislation introduced this week, said State Senator Jim Holperin (D-Eagle River) who co-sponsored the bill.

"Tax credits are already available to dairies, meat packing plants and food processing facilities if those businesses upgrade, expand or modernize equipment or facilities," Holperin said, "but the total amount of tax credits is capped and this legislation raises the cap.

Holperin said the dairy manufacturing tax credit cap would rise from \$700,000 to \$1 million, while the cap on tax credits available to meat and food processing facilities would go from \$700,000 to \$1.2 million.

"Typically, equipment or facility upgrades are accompanied by the addition of good, family-supporting jobs," Holperin added. "That's the main goal."

Increasing the maximum amount of tax credits available to food processors and warehouse facilities could have a positive impact on northern Wisconsin businesses which process or store cranberries, potatoes and sweet corn, he said.

Another element of the legislation would offer a 10% to 12% tax credit to anyone who invests in a Wisconsin Community Development Finance Institution (CDFI). These local lending organizations sanctioned by the U.S. Department of the Treasury take the cash invested in them and make small loans to businesses that may have difficulty finding credit elsewhere. The CDFIs also offer financial counseling and advice to small businesses in rural areas.



## **Schoolyard Habitat Across** Wisconsin

A few years ago at the elementary school, a garden project was started that was later expanded to include the high school in 2009. The intention of this project is to educate students and the community on how to restore native habitats. Project coordinators plan to use the garden for different ecological studies and environmental topics, such as the impact invasive species have on local native plants and animals. They hope to instill a cultural awareness of the environment and society's impact on it.

The schoolyard habitat project was brought to Wabeno by the USDA Forest Service. Funding for this project has been provided through a grant, which will last until May 2011. Community members have also donated supplies and equipment. Various aspects of the project take place within the school and the school forest.

It takes many people to be involved in a project like this! Creation of the garden could not have been done without the help of school faculty members and students. Ms. Vaclav, WHS biology teacher, states, "This is a collaborative project that couldn't have been accomplished without the help of other teachers, community members, students, administration, and our maintenance staff. Mrs. Pries and Mr. Exferd have been extremely helpful in every aspect of this project, and we couldn't have done it without them." The other teachers in the WHS science department, Mr. Twardowski and Mr. Taylor, have assisted Ms. Vaclav throughout this project along with Nicole Shutt from the USDA Forest Service.

The students in the science department along with the CDS class have played the largest roles in the production of the garden. Each class has played a different role in the process. The Biology class plans and leads the project by helping with seed collection, stratification of the seeds, sowing of the seeds, data collection on all the plants, and finally planting. Nicole Shutt is the main contact person from the Forest Service, contributing to the success of the transformation of our Wabeno District schoolyard to a native plant garden.
