## Crandon 4th Celebration

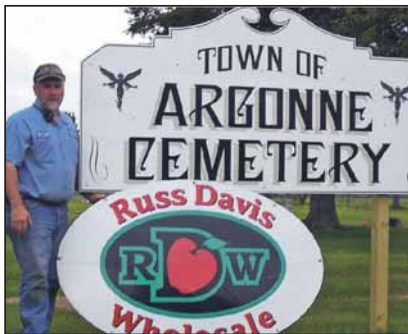

Ironically the sign suffered no damage except for the holes where the screws were once located. Town employees also stated they had found several pieces of industrial roof insulation strewn about as well.

We are sure Rick and the Russ Davis company will have a great story to tell about the great flight and finding of a sign from a town 70 miles away for many years to come.

Fireworks can be seen anywhere you go when it is around the 4th of July and Crandon is no exception. This year however, there was a chance that the residents of the area would not get to see the night sky lit up with fireworks.

Budget cuts have had to be made by everyone and it costs the Crandon Fire Department about \$9,000 for the 4th of July fireworks display. The department's only fund raiser is the 4th and they have to spend a lot of money to make the event happen before adding the cost of the fireworks.

Mayor Rob Jaeger heard about the possible celebration without the fireworks, so he set out to see what he could do to make them possible. He went before the Crandon Fire Department and found that he would have to come up with \$3,000. Mr. Jaeger set out looking for donations and three gracious businesses helped out.

Co-Vantage Credit Union, Schaefer's IGA Food Mart and Associated Bank each donated \$1,000 each for this years 4th of July fireworks.

Mayor Jaeger felt that if Crandon had to take a year off from fireworks, that we might not have fireworks again. Plans are under way to have a Save the Fireworks 5K Walk/Run next year and Schaefer's is thinking of setting up a program for helping with the financial burden for future years.

## Lincoln Building Committee meets

The Town of Lincoln Building Committee met last Thursday, June 23rd, at the Lincoln Town Hall. The subject was the proposed new town hall for the Town of Lincoln. The committee discussed the views of the building committee before the appearance of Keller Construction for the initial design meeting.

The first part of the meeting, the nine-member building committee reviewed possible sizes and types of buildings in comparison to other area town halls. Sizes, numbers and locations of office rooms were discussed. In addition, possible floor coverings were discussed, as were types of ceilings and possible electrical needs. Windows, doors, energy efficiencies and types of heating were also discussed, as well as security issues.

The issue of whether the new structure would include a community center was discussed, and the size of such a building was discussed without making a decision on the type of building.

Keller Construction will be reporting to the committee on July 19th with several options after reviewing codes, which would have to be considered and adhered to.

Everything on this project is tentative, and there will be numerous meetings on the issue, with an eventual public hearing and input from the Lincoln taxpayers.

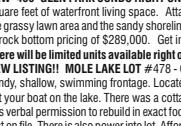

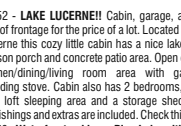

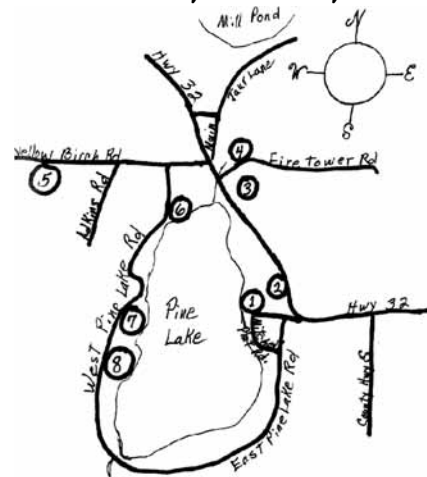

**Balanced budget will meet critical transportation needs** submitted by Mark Gottlieb, P.E. Secretary, Wisconsin Department of Transportation

The 2011-2013 biennial budget signed into law this week by Governor Scott Walker is a balanced budget that allows the state to meet critical transportation needs over the next two years.

The budget puts an emphasis on the Governor's vision for creating 250,000 jobs and improving government to lay the groundwork for future prosperity. It provides a clear plan for tackling today's challenges and making Wisconsin's future bright.

The transportation elements in the budget support job creation, maintain and preserve the state's transportation infrastructure and provide the mobility and safety travelers depend on to move throughout the state each day.

Transportation needs are financed without increasing gas taxes or registration fees. The budget honors the commitment to end roads on the transportation fund and recognizes the will of voters in 53 counties who overwhelmingly passed advisory referendums to ask that fuel taxes, registration fees and other user charges be used only for transportation programs.

Transportation investments over the next two years will allow several large and economically important highway projects to move closer to completion. This includes work on the Zoo Interchange and I-94 project in southeast Wisconsin, the Interstate 39/90 corridor from Madison to the Illinois state line and expansion of US Highway 10 and Highway 441 in the Fox Valley. These projects are critical not only in their respective regions, but for the entire state.

At the same time, hundreds of smaller road and bridge improvements will move forward in every corner of the state. The budget also provides increases for state highway maintenance to ensure potholes are filled and roadways plowed. These investments contribute to local economies and provide job opportunities. In the long term, they help create the quality transportation network state businesses need to grow and succeed.

Nearly every citizen in Wisconsin is impacted by the work of the Wisconsin Department of Transportation through improvement projects, the traffic safety efforts of the Wisconsin State Patrol or the assistance to drivers and vehicle owners provided through the Division of Motor Vehicles. The budget supports our efforts to move forward on new e-government initiatives to achieve the highest levels of customer service.

In summary, the 2011-13 state biennial budget recognizes the importance of a great transportation system to support economic growth and development throughout Wisconsin.

Dear Editor,

I am extremely disappointed by the Governor and legislature leaders for cutting the energy efficiency program Focus on Energy in the recent budget. My business works with homeowners to save money on their energy bills by reducing energy use, and I have seen firsthand the success of this program.

At first glance, it might seem that this is just another example of cutting programs to balance a tough budget, but that is just not the case. Contrary to what the public may think, Focus on Energy dollars never touch the state's coffers, as the program is funded by utilities. Cutting the funding, as set forth in the budget language, does nothing to balance the budget. Rather it 'fluffs up' the numbers to make it seem the Governor's budget reduces deficit spending without raising taxes.

The funding that was cut from the program would have created 7000 to 9000 jobs and saved up to \$350 million per year on energy bills, this according to an independent study by the Energy Center of Wisconsin. And, by helping us avoid the need to build new power plants and transmission lines, Focus on Energy also plays an important role in keeping energy bills down for all of Wisconsinites, which should be top priority in these economically constrained times.

The decision to cut Focus on Energy funding is particularly thoughtless and certainly bears further scrutiny. The Governor and his people made a promise to program representatives to give this issue further thought prior to signing the budget and I hope the legislature will work toward a compromise so the people of Wisconsin can continue to enjoy the proven savings the Focus on Energy program provides.

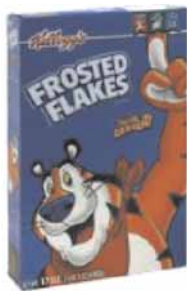

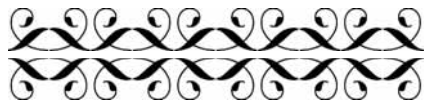

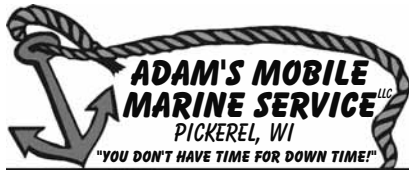
