
The July 4th Royalty will be crowned at 8:30 p.m.,

Lincoln Building Committee meets

The Town of Lincoln Building Committee met last Thursday, June 23rd, at the Lincoln Town Hall. The subject was the proposed new town hall for the Town of Lincoln. The committee discussed the views of the building committee before the appearance of Keller Construction for the initial design meeting.

The first part of the meeting, the nine-member building committee reviewed possible sizes and types of buildings in comparison to other area town halls. Sizes, numbers and locations of office rooms were discussed. In addition, possible floor coverings were discussed, as were types of ceilings and possible electrical needs. Windows, doors, energy efficiencies and types of heating were also discussed, as well as security issues.

The issue of whether the new structure would include a community center was discussed, and the size of such a building was discussed without making a decision on the type of building.

Keller Construction will be reporting to the committee on July 19th with several options after reviewing codes, which would have to be considered and adhered to.

Everything on this project is tentative, and there will be numerous meetings on the issue, with an eventual public hearing and input from the Lincoln taxpayers.

I am extremely disappointed by the Governor and legislature leaders for cutting the energy efficiency rogram Focus on Energy in the recent budget. My business works with homeowners to save money on their energy bills by reducing energy use, and I have seen firsthand the success of this program.

At first glance, it might seem that this is just another example of cutting programs to balance a tough budget, but that is just not the case. Contrary to what the public may think. Focus on Energy dollars never touch the state's coffers, as the program is funded by utilities. Cutting the funding, as set forth in the budget language, does nothing to balance the budget. Rather it 'fluffs up' the numbers to make it seem the Governor's budget reduces deficit spending without raising taxes.

The funding that was cut from the program would have created 7000 to 9000 jobs and saved up to \$350 million per year on energy bills, this according to an independent study by the Energy Center of Wisconsin.
