## Polish Heritage Days in Armstrong Creek

Armstrong Creek will be celebrating its 21st annual Polish Heritage Days, July 15th and 16th this year.

Starting off the weekend, Friday July 15th, you can enjoy dancing to the sounds of The New Generation Polka Band from Pulaski WI from 6:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. The crowning of Miss Armstrong Creek will be at 9:00 p.m., with the raffle drawing to follow. Polish food and beverages will be served. Friday night dance admission is \$3.00 with 10 and under free.

Saturday July 16th is the highlight of the weekend. The day starts at 11:00 a.m. with an authentic Polish Mass at the St. Stanislaus Kostka Catholic Church. Visitors will see ornate Polish costumes and hear beautiful Polish hymns while attending the mass. After the mass, a parade proceeds from the church to the town park where one can enjoy an afternoon of fun.

Polka music will fill the park all day, starting off with Roger Majeski and the Harmony Kings of Mosinee from 12:30 p.m. till 5:30 p.m. If your feet are still willing, you can dance the night away to Aaron Socha's LIVEwire Polka Band of Green Bay, from 6:00 p.m. till 11:00 p.m. Throughout the day the park will bustle with activities for the young and old alike, including games for the kids, horse drawn wagon rides, craft tables, a silent auction, car show and petting zoo. The smell of homemade Polish foods will fill the air, making it irresistible for you to sample the foods which will include pierogi, polska kielbasa, kraut, Golabki, Kluski and Kapusta and mouth watering bakery. Saturday Park admission is \$5.00, 10 and under free.

If the last 2 days haven't tired you out and you want to enjoy the countryside of Armstrong Creek on foot, the committee will hold a 4k Walk/Run at 8am on Sunday July 17th. Preregistration is suggested but not mandatory. Sign in is at 7:30 a.m., registration forms will be available.

## Kim Simac, Candidate for State Senator-12th District

Kim Simac has been a resident of Eagle River, Wisconsin since 1982 where she has raised her 9 children and 8 grandchildren with a 9th one due in August. Kim and her husband, Butch, are both small business owners. Kim runs a small farm which is also home to the Great Northern Adventure Company where she trains horses and riders. Her company hosts an overnight camp for two weeks over the summer geared at teaching young girls how to ride and care for horses. In addition, Kim has self-published several patriotic children's books with the prevailing theme of American pride.

After 14 Senate Democrats fled the state during debating on the Budget Repair Bill of 2011, Kim led the effort to recall her senator, Jim Holperin. The Committee to Recall Jim Holperin was the first such committee filed in Wisconsin that year. Kim and her committee gathered over 23,000 signatures through the 90 day process. She received such an overwhelming response to her leadership through the recall process that she decided to run in the recall election herself. She declared her candidacy on May 5th to overwhelming positive response.

## The 25th Annual Steam-Up Days in Wabeno



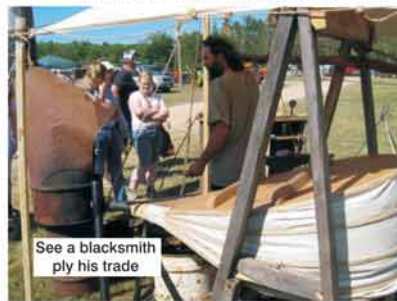

## Nashville Community Center nears completion



After months of research, planning, supply-sourcing and penny-pinching, the Nashville Town Board is pleased to relate that its new community center will be ready for occupancy in late August or early September. This approximate million dollar facility is located on County Q off County DD near Arbutus Lake in Forest County.

The majority of funding for building the structure was secured through a grant from the Wisconsin Department of Commerce and a grant with loan commitment from the US Department of Agriculture. Board members want to emphasize that there will be no increase in town taxes!

Residents are invited to a public hearing to be held on July 26, 2011 at 7:00 PM in the South Office Building. Here the board members will provide a progress report, a review of the important community benefits the facility will provide and open the floor to specific discussion of resident interest related to the center.

The town would like to express their appreciation to the Laona State Bank for its help with the project. The terms the bank offered for providing interim financing (paying bills between receipt of grant funds) were very beneficial to the town. The money saved (vs budget) enabled the town to put more money into the building project. Bank personnel "were great to work with" and the efforts of Bank Vice President Ted Ison proved an excellent example of community relations. The board also mentioned the Pickerel Volunteer Fire Department for praise. Volunteers installed an emergency underground water supply tank free of charge and a civic-minded donor supplied the tank, also free of charge.

Residents and businesses of the greater community are invited to be part of the project by contributing toward outfitting and furnishing the building and helping to landscape the site. These needs are not covered by grant funds. All contributors or honorees will have their name laser-etched on an individual tile permanently displayed inside the building.

For individuals, the inscription is etched on a 2" x 4" mirror that is affixed to a 6" x 6" ceramic tile. The cost of an individual tile is \$50. For businesses, the mirror is 4" x 4" on to a 6" x 12" ceramic tile at a cost of \$200. To date, about 75 contributions have been received including one from Pioneer Express who generously donated printing and publishing expenses.

As these projects happen in our area about once in a lifetime, here is your chance to be recognized as a donor to a very civic-minded and significant cause or to honor a family, a loved one or a special friend by purchasing a commemorative tile in their name. These tiles make wonderful gifts.

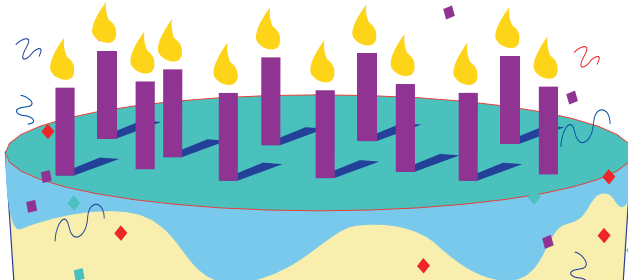

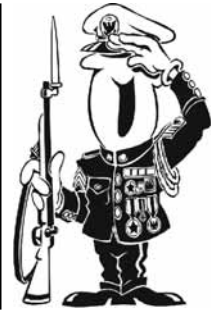

With a heavy heart I will be closing Brown Street Books in downtown Rhinelander. After months of contemplation on whether to stay open or close, to sell or not, we will begin our closing sales Monday July, 11th, with plans to be closed some time in August.

Times are changing due to technology but also the economy and Main Streets such as Rhinelander having a difficult time competing with the big stores. 18 years ago Brown Street Books opened its doors, the same time as Amazon. We were holding our own until on-line sales cut into our sales with their aggressive discounts and now their e-reader.

Foot traffic in my store has decreased steadily over the last year which has affected sales. "Paper" books are selling on line oft times cheaper than my cost, and Kindle, Nook, and E Readers are nibbling away at independent book stores such as mine with E-Books, making it financially difficult to keep my bookstore solvent. And I understand that people need to watch how they spend their money. We are so fortunate to have a wonderful library downtown.

I have been blessed with wonderful booksellers, many faithful customers, and landlords who are great to work with. Owning my own store has been an extremely rewarding experience which I will always treasure. The decision to close is so sad for me because I love my book store and all the memories such as our Harry Potter midnight parties and when author Jan Brett came to Rhinelander.

In the past month when customers came in saying, "We're so glad you are still here", I thought "will I be able to still be here? How? Wrestling since January on how I could still remain open, May and June sales told me I needed to close.

To customers who were searching for obscure books which often times we were able to locate for them for all the special orders we were able to get for customers - and for those who had no computer or did not feel

comfortable ordering on line - we will no longer be able to fill their needs and that is so heartbreaking for me.

The number of area book clubs have grown from ones like Over readers Anonymous (possibly the area's longest running book club), to over 35 book clubs. They registered their monthly selections with us which was so wonderful seeing all the book lovers connecting with others, the choices of books they discussed, to be able to suggest possible choices for their club's next read but also to have their book selection in our store for them.

To now face my faithful customers will be extremely difficult as I feel I am letting them down for they are losing a local, independent business with an owner and friendly, knowledgeable staff who have worked so hard these past years striving to give customers the best service possible.

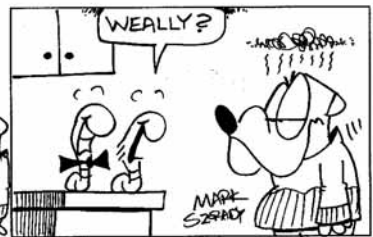

## Sheriff's Department Investigates Burglary

On 6/23/11, the Forest County Sheriff's Dept. Responded to a burglary in progress at a residence near Roberts Lake in the Town of Freedom. Attentive neighbors contacted the Sheriff's Office after they observed three subjects who were in the process of burglarizing a residence and taking a motorcycle and an ATV. The suspects fled the scene and a manhunt ensued. The Sheriff along with Forest Co. Deputies, the City of Crandon Police, the Town of Laona Police, the Town of Wabeno Police & K-9, and a DNR Warden responded and took one suspect into custody after a short time.

Further investigation led to search warrants being executed in Oconto County where two more suspects were arrested. The search warrants produced several stolen items including numerous guns, electronic equipment, a stolen car, a second stolen ATV and a marijuana grow operation. Sheriff Dennee credited the neighbors who were attentive enough to take down the license plate of the vehicle involved and gave the officers the description of the suspects. Sheriff Dennee also credited the teamwork between the several law enforcement agencies involved and the District Attorneys Office for the hard work and determination put forth on an investigation that continued to grow over several days.

The investigation is on-going as new information is being received about other crimes.

**New role for sports, gun clubs:  
 Find next generation of hunters**

**DNR shooting sports coordinator sets goal of 2,000 new participants for 2011**

Here's a thought for Wisconsin hunters: Picture your kids' teachers, your hair stylist, grocery store clerk, doctor, or neighbor kid enjoying their first hunt. You can make it a reality and help preserve a Wisconsin tradition, and the Department of Natural Resources will help.

It's an exciting time to be in sports, rod and gun and conservation clubs. Club members have a focused sense of purpose and challenge -- find the next generation of hunters. Think about recruiting participants from your community. Reach beyond the local hunter education class to other adult friends and their children.

Hunting offers an opportunity to meet new people, exercise, connect with nature, spend quality time with family and friends, and have the opportunity to bring home high quality food. Let's share it and see if we can introduce hunting to at least 2,000 new people this year. I know a lot of hunters who want to help, and I think we can do it.

The reality facing hunting in Wisconsin and other states is the majority of participants are Baby Boomer generation, marching through middle age into their 60s with reduced participation in the more recent generations. The gradual loss of the hunting population threatens to reduce the relevance of hunting to our strong conservation community.

In the challenge there is also opportunity -- all those baby boomers also represent an army of qualified mentors for the next decade. Wisconsin citizens recognize the importance of hunters to conservation in our state and they strongly support us. It's up to us as hunters -- as well as business organizations, youth groups, churches and neighborhood organizations -- to make sure that great tradition continues.

A good way to introduce people to hunting is a Learn to Hunt event. Nearly 1,000 joined a Learn to Hunt turkey event this past spring. If your group hosted an event, make sure you send in the final roster to the DNR at Learn to Hunt Coordinator LE/8, PO Box 7921, Madison, WI, 53707.

The processes and application forms sponsors need to organize a Learn to Hunt event are available on the DNR website. Sponsors should work closely with the local wildlife biologist or warden when planning an event, and ensure at least one of the event instructors is a certified Hunter Education Instructor. Remember, this opportunity is open to novice hunters of all ages. Consider planning an event for parents who don't hunt and include their children.

Mentors are screened by the DNR using background checks at least two weeks before the hunt. There is also a reimbursement program through which groups can receive \$25 per novice hunter to help cover the costs of hosting a learn-to-hunt event. If you are interested in hosting an event or have any questions about LTH, see the DNR website: or contact Warnke at the number below.

The DNR initiated the Learn to Hunt program in 1998 to provide novice hunters of all ages opportunities to experience a hunt with

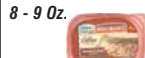

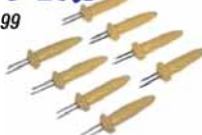

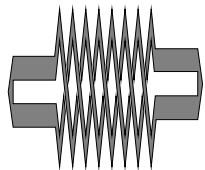
