

Added Jim Johnson, "WXPR is a valuable asset to the Northwoods. We are very excited to be able to make a significant impact on the future of WXPR and its service to

Fiocchi says that if fundraising can be completed by the end of the year, the station will be moving to the new location sometime in the spring.


