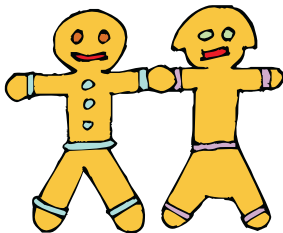

The annual Flashlight Parade and Tree Lighting drew a big crowd this year, thanks to milder temperatures, with an estimated 140 participants. Those who participated in the parade were treated to the fabulous light display at Dr. Rebecca Perry's residence. After the parade, participants were impressed to see a much bigger tree than last year was used as the community Christmas tree.

Wisconsin Public Service Corporation stepped up to cover much of the cost of the new led lights, with the City First Impressions program funding the remainder. Wisconsin Public Service also sent Asplundh over with their bucket truck to place the lights on the 55 foot spruce tree in the center of the Forest County Courthouse Square. Bob Becker provided electrical assistance. To nicely top it off, a six-foot star was fabricated and donated by Keith Stamper of Related Fab & Prep.

Participants then gathered at the Chamber office for free cookies (donated by Schaefer's IGA) and free hot chocolate (donated by Citgo Quik Mart). Many kids were able to sit on Santa's lap and tell him what they hoped to get for Christmas.

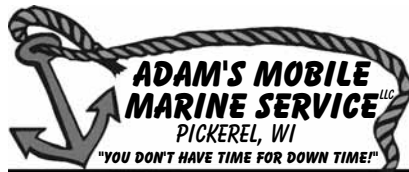

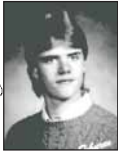
