

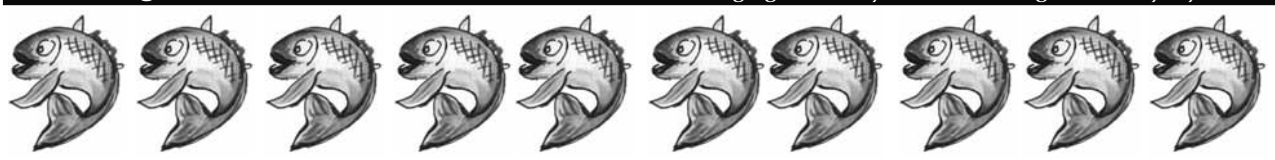

Silver Dollar Saddle Club

Do you like to ride horse? Do you like good company and conversation? If so, this is the club for you.

In February, the Silver Dollar Saddle Club held its yearly organizational meeting. Throughout the years, the club has participated in a number of equestrian and community activities. The Silver Dollar Saddle Club was established in 1962. Besides our monthly trail rides, in the 60's and 70's the club held horse/gaming shows in both Wabeno and Lakewood. We've had overnight wagon/trail rides from Mountain to Lakewood.

We've also been active in the community by awarding college scholarships to seniors in four different high schools. We've donated funds to the human society and local 4-H clubs.

We presently have members from Marinette, Oneida, Forest, Florence and Northern Oconto counties. We get together monthly during the riding season at different locations to enjoy the great outdoors. Many of us have federal, state, or county lands to ride and appreciate right in our backyards.

Now we're turning over a new leaf. Last year our club decided to channel its efforts towards improving our local equestrian riding trail. Otter Springs Trail is the only public equestrian trail in Forest County. It's owned/managed by Forest Country. It's used for hiking, biking, cross-country skiing, and equestrian use. It consists of 8 miles of rolling forested land with scenic views and stream crossings. Over the years, the county has maintained the trail and worked to improve the site by adding signage.

This year, our club has applied for a grant from the Wisconsin Horse Council and is working with the County Forestry Administrator to further develop the trailhead to include 8 horse campsites. We hope to add hitching posts, high wire lines, picnic tables, fire rings, and mounting blocks. The current trail is nice for a 1/2 day trip, but really there's not enough trail to constitute a full day trip so we've decided to add over 3 miles of additional trail to our current system.

In working with the county we've also been able to get the Nicolet State Trail and Wolf River State trails in Forest County open for equestrian use.

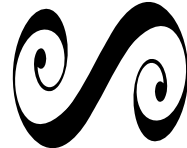

Too Much of a Good Thing

Growing up, if I said I was hungry and my next meal was still a ways off, my mom offered me a piece of fruit or some graham crackers with skim milk. End of story. Nowadays, snacking has become a stressful issue for parents, along with what to feed their kids in general. And the steady stream of news about childhood obesity doesn't make things any easier.

Moms who are worried about their kids' snack habits should first make sure there's no skipping or skimping on **BREAKFAST**, which often leads to out-of-control munching and too many calories consumed over the course of the day. A good a.m. meal should contain some protein, fat and carbs with fiber so kids stay satisfied until lunch. A small bowl (about a cup's worth) of 100% whole grain cereal that's low in added sugar (less than 7 grams per serving) with skim milk and some blueberries or a banana should hit the spot. When time is tight, a hard-boiled egg, a whole-wheat pita and an orange are ready to travel.

A balanced **LUNCH** should include something from all five food groups and be substantial enough to fuel kids through afternoon classes. But it's usually too long a stretch from lunch to dinner, especially if they have sports or other activities, so have a snack handy when they get in the car or walk in the door. Eating a little something is okay - just don't let it turn into a free-for-all.

Suggestions: a small whole-wheat wrap with turkey, lettuce and tomato; sliced apples or whole-wheat bread with nut butter; cut-up fresh fruit and yogurt; a smoothie made with fruit and skim milk; or whole-grain tortilla chips with bean dip or salsa.

Come **DINNERTIME**, sit down as a family whenever possible. Research has shown that kids who regularly have meals with their parents eat more fruit, vegetables and calcium-rich foods. Supper is the perfect time to model healthy eating habits. Divide the plate into quarters, with one section made up of fruit (dessert), another of vegetables and the balance whole grains and protein; also add some low-fat dairy. A good example is a stir-fry with meat, chicken or fish and lots of vegetables served on brown rice. For a sweet ending, try a half cup of pineapple chunks topped with low-fat yogurt.

Ultimately, managing your kids' diet is about consistently providing healthy options - and modeling by making good choices yourself most of the time. If you are truly concerned, consider speaking with a registered dietitian. Ask your pediatrician for a suggestion or go to eatright.org/programs/rdfinder/.

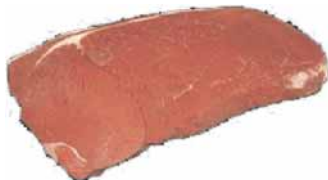

Dear Editor

State Representative Jeff Mursau, 36th District stated in your paper last week that the new pension contributions save taxpayers \$6.8 million annually. He used an older version of a graph dated 3/15/11 from the Legislative Fiscal Bureau. In this estimate Crandon School District has 971 students and in the new one dated 6/23/11 they have 941, which is the same numbers I got from the school. This is important because school state aid is based on enrollment

Based on 971 employed on his table it shows that the school district saved \$342,600 by having teachers pay into their health and pensions plans. According to the new figures and numbers provided by the School District they received \$300,000 instead of the \$342,600. The Crandon School District for the school year 10-11 they received Three million one hundred seventy two thousand in state aid...In the 11-12 school year in state aid they received two million eight hundred fifty one thousand, for a total loss of \$321,000. This lost was offset by the \$300,000 taken from the teacher salaries. This left the school district short \$21,000.

This saved the state of Wisconsin \$321,000 in the state budget and the School District lost \$321,000 in state aid. The teachers lost between \$5,000 to \$7,000 annually in take home pay. The local communities lost between \$325,000 to 455,000 in locally earned dollars. In this sense the Governor's budget is working and Mursau is right if the goal was only to help the state budget on the back of local schools and communities. This plan may for wealthier communities that have the tax base to support their school system. However our school district and Mursau's Assembly District depends on state aid to provide 2/3 of their budget it is a failure for us. For example Wausaukee County had over a billion dollars in home sales just last month according to the home sales report just released. Forest County had 0 home sales on the same report.

Home sales translated into tax base. Forest County has less than 16% taxable land and a growing elderly population. This leaves the tax burden falling on just a few thousand people as Forest County has less than 8,000 population, and yet the state is treating us like all other wealthier and larger counties. Also remember that the state will not let the school district raise taxes to offset the decrease in revenue.

There was some Obama stimulus money left over from the 9-10 school year and this helped the school district this year, and now that is gone. Six teachers retired saving the district this year \$600,000. that they can only afford to hire one teacher to replace the six, because that is all the budget supports. They said that this \$600,000 was a one year revenue and will hurt our District as they can only afford to replace one of the six, leaving the students with five less teachers. The District will be looking at other ways of cutting the funding. It was pointed out that a school within a thirty mile radius was looking at cutting their Janitorial staff and the school would contract the service out. Some schools are looking at cutting out bus service for some students and activities.

Small business owners do you realize with this 5.8 % reduction in the salaries of these 65 teachers and staff that is about \$5,000 to \$7,000 less take home pay annually for them making us all but the state of Wisconsin losers. Teachers from just Crandon, Laona, Wabeno, and every state worker in the county are going to have less money to shop, buy gas, eat out, remodel, get new roofs etc. Mursau ended his article by saying, "Expect further financial efficiencies and savings to be available in the near future." Just my opinion but I doubt that we can afford any more of the state savings. The northern part of the state's less populated communities bore the brunt of the Act 10 plan. Our road aid was cut as was our Tourism dollars while the southern part of the state got more than their fair share. Badger care is going to be taking a major hit and so many of our small local business people depend on this program as do our low income workers. Our Social Service Department took a million dollar hit this year. I guess I have a hard time understanding how our Representative can support all of our losses without informing us of the true depth of the loss revenue.

Animal Resource Fund News

We have a busy year scheduled ahead. We will, of course, continue with our weekly stocking of shelves at the food pantry in the NEWCAP building in Crandon.

I have been setting up at the Wednesday Flea Market at the Nashville Town Hall, helping to bring in some much needed working revenue to keep up with the above food bills and also the never ending vet bills. We have taken so many cats into our foster care system, and with them, comes the expense of vaccinating, spay/neutering, etc., before we can advertise them for adoption.

When we cannot find room for them in foster care, we try any other avenue, rather than just saying "No". A few days ago, I received a call from a gentleman who needed to bring in kittens. We had no place for them, so I asked him to call F.C.H.S. Apparently they could not take them either, so now they are with an associate of A.R.F. in Lakewood. This is the on-going story for the poor cats, not only in our area, but it seems across the country. I have said for many years that the backbone of any animal welfare organization is a stringent neutering program. NO animal should ever leave a rescue or shelter **UNaltered!**

A.R.F. is once again hosting a shot clinic, which will be held at the Nashville Town Hall. This is scheduled for Sat, May 19, from 8:00 A.M. until Noon. For everyone's protection we have to insist that all dogs be leashed, and that you have your cat either crated or otherwise under control. We will be asking for a \$5.00 DONATION for each animal, which will cover both the rabies and the distemper mixed vaccine. We ask this only to help us with the costs of the supplies. Everyone involved is a volunteer. We do this as a public service, hoping to reach as many animals as possible, whose owners find it difficult to meet the costs of preventive medical care for their pets. These shots are so important to protect your pet from life-threatening diseases. This year, with the moving of Dr Tracey Hageny to another state, we have been fortunate to acquire services of a new-comer to our area, Dr. Scott McKay. Dr. McKay has a mobile veterinary service, which will be invaluable to those with farm animals and horses, and pets that are difficult to transport. One of our Board members, Amanda Collette, will soon be announcing her Pics for Pets, a fund raiser for A.R.F. She will be scheduling sessions of photography involving pets or pets with their families.

We will soon be advertising the date of our annual rummage sale. We have to work around the dates that the Nashville Town Hall is rented for other events. With the recent renovations of the hall those events have been picking up.

We are honored to once again be included in the schedule of the Kentucky Day celebration, and also Art In The Square. We will be serving strawberry shortcake and sweet tea at Kentucky Day, and our usual caramel apples at Art in the Square.

We invite you to come visit us at any event, learn what we do each and every day to alleviate the distress of animals in peril, and what YOU can personally do to help animals. For those wonderful individuals who have taken it upon themselves to feed and shelter animals who are "making it on their own", God Bless you, and A.R.F. will always be by your side to assist.


