## Free Health Fair at Ministry Medical Group in Laona

(Laona, WI) The Laona Community Health Fair will be held Saturday, August 11, from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 Noon at the Ministry Medical Group clinic located at 4876 Mill Street. The health fair will feature exhibits, demonstrations, health information and free clinical testing.

"We really look forward to this event because it gives us an opportunity to interact with the community and provide free health services," said Clinic Supervisor Jodi Stamper. "We are also hosting a wide range of exhibits and information from local organizations such as the Forest County Health Department who will be offering T dap tetanus/pertussis immunizations."

Free clinical testing will include fasting cholesterol testing, blood pressure, blood sugar testing, skin cancer and visual acuity. Providers recommend fasting for a period of at least 12 hours before a fasting cholesterol test. Appointments are not necessary and the free screenings are available on a first come first serve basis. Ministry Weight Management and Advance Directives will also be featured during the health fair. The opportunity to dispose of unused medications will be offered.

"Please join us for the health fair," added Stamper. "Being informed about your health care and the services offered locally is the most important step you can take for living a healthy and active life." Staff will be available to answer your questions about the clinic, specific services and programs.

Can stovewood really be special? Well, yes. This stovewood was used to build a building. What is stovewood? It is simply wood for wood-burning stoves. In days of yore, it was the off cuttings from sawlogs. Normally used to create heat in a stove, some bright person thought laying these pieces in a straight pile surrounded by mortar, created an approximately two-foot thick wall. It was solid and gave good insulation, and surely required a great bit of physical effort to install.

What is special right now is that it is probably one of the last standing old stovewood buildings. (*Editor's Note: Stovewood construction has been the rage with some modern homesteaders for quite some time, and there are books written by author Rob Roy on how to build your own.*) So, if you missed the tour on July 4th, here is another chance.

The hard-working volunteers at the Stovewood Museum will be sacrificing a pig in your honor! That is, there will be roast pig, a great bake sale, more good food, old items to ponder, history to observe, antique cars, the Roger Geldon one-man band and more.

Crandon had a visitor last week. Deb Mullins gave us a call from the Hotel and said an interesting fellow was eating supper at the bar, and said he had arrived on a bicycle. To be more precise, he was on a tricycle!

Gary Havas is from San Luis Obispo, California, and he is a cyclist. He decided to take a long-distance trip, and, he says, it was appropriate that he started on April 1st on this very long ride.

He left California and pedaled to Florida, then up the east coast to Maine. Heading west, he cheated a little when he took the ferry from Ludington, Michigan to Manitowoc. He traveled north to Shawano and Mattoon and thence to Crandon, where he ate at the Hotel Crandon and stayed the night at the Main Street Inn.

As he traveled, he spent a lot of nights in a tent, but he also had a list of fellow cyclists who are always willing to provide a bed, meal and a shower to people traveling by pedal. He slept at published camp grounds when tenting.

Gary had logged about 6,800 miles when he reached Crandon. After pedaling to Oregon and down the coast to home, he will have seen about 11,500 miles of American highways, and usually secondary roads for the sake of safety. He says that he has only encountered about 14 bad people who have crowded him on the road or been rude, which he considers insignificant on such a long trip.

*Those who follow federal timber issues will remember that the logging industry in the Lake States held two important meetings with state and federal elected officials last year on the availability of national forest timber in the Lake States. Also included in the second meeting, held at Nicolet College, was Forest Service Chief Tidwell. The debate has been ongoing, as can be seen in the following press release.*

### Press Statement on Wood Products and the National Forests

Federal Forest Resource Coalition (FFRC) Executive Director Bill Imbergamo issued the following statement:

"We applaud the Forest Service for their efforts to increase timber outputs from the National Forest System. As this spring and summer's fires have demonstrated, these forests need to be managed, and that management can produce valuable timber to help keep hardworking sawmill, paper mill, and biomass energy workers employed. We're concerned, however, that Chief Tidwell and Secretary Vilsack appear minimize the role that our sawmills and paper plants play in keeping our forests healthy. The National Forest System is accumulating dead and dying trees at an alarming rate, with growth exceeding harvest by a ratio of almost 6 to 1. With over 40 million acres infested with bark beetles and other pests, our 650+ member companies can provide jobs while restoring forest health. We hope the Forest Service will not become so distracted trying to build a new - and uncertain - biomass economy that they will let their existing customers and our 350,000 jobs die for lack of timber."

Porcupine Mountains Wilderness State Park, in Michigan's Upper Peninsula, will soon become the home and inspiration for landscape artist Betsy Popp. Betsy was chosen for a three-week residency in this year's Artist-In-Residence Program at the park.

A widely recognized and award-winning artist, Betsy studied at UW-Stevens Point and graduated with a broad field art education degree. She then obtained her Masters of Fine Arts degree from the Academy of Art University, San Francisco, California.

Since 1996 Betsy has owned and operated "Betsy Popp - Fine Art Gallery" in Townsend, Wisconsin which also serves as her working studio and custom frame shop. For nearly 20 years, Betsy has instructed adult studio art courses through Northeast Wisconsin Technical College and throughout the country. More recently she has taught art history and a watercolor studio course through Upper Iowa University.

Being an "artist-in-Residence" is not new to Betsy. 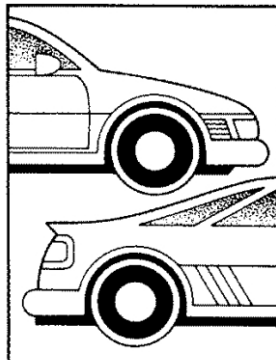



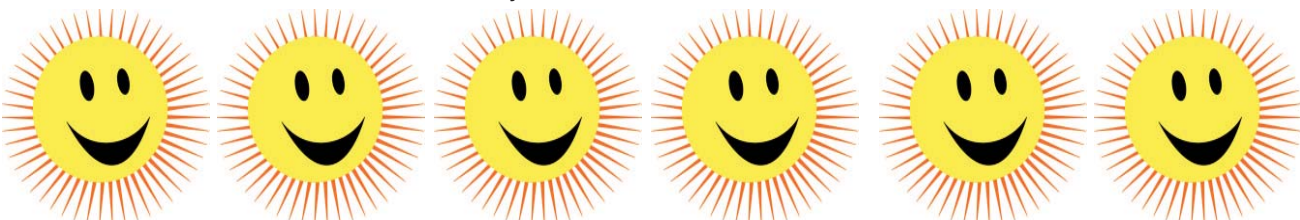
