A big wagon-load of fat, juicy sweet corn will be cooked in a giant kettle on the beach and given away free to everyone, all you want, all day. As always, the corn will be cooked to perfection under the watchful eyes of WWII Army veteran AI Eberhard, who says plenty of butter will be on hand for dipping the corn, and any corn in the husk, not eaten, will be sold at below market price to first-comers at the end of the festivities.

The Corn Boil will begin at noon, rain or shine. Games, raffles and drawings for all ages, including small children, await many eager players. By popular demand, plenty of juicy steaks will again be raffled off.

2nd Annual Log Roller's Pride Ride



Nicolet Resource Advisory Committee seeks project ideas

Laona, Wis., August 9 2012 Project proposals for funding through the Secure Rural Schools Act Nicolet Resource Advisory Committee (Nicolet RAC) are currently being accepted. Project funds can be used for projects that improve the maintenance of existing infrastructure (e.g. roads, trails, and campgrounds), enhance forest ecosystems, and restore and improve land health and water quality. Projects proposal may also include the control of exotic weeds, the re-establishment of native species, and/or the improvement of wildlife and fish habitat.

The Nicolet RAC has an estimated \$90,000 to fund natural resource-related projects on or directly affecting National Forest lands, in Forest, Florence and Oconto counties. Work can be completed by Forest Service personnel, through partnership agreements or by open-bid contracting with individuals and corporations.

Anyone may submit project proposals including; members of the public, non-profit organizations and local governments. Project proposals forms are available online at http://www.fs.fed.us/r9/cnnf/. Proposals forms will be accepted at the Laona District Office, 4978 Hwy. 8 W, Laona, WI 5454. The Nicolet RAC will accept proposals through August 20, 2012

The class will be limited to 25 participants, and the fee for the class is \$10.







A small group of Crandon Middle School students choose to spend two and a half weeks of their summer vacation showing their Cardinal Pride.

As part of the summer school program, students painted a thirty foot mural of a cardinal in the high school/middle school hallway. The mural was completed totally by the students from conception to finished product. The cardinal was designed by high school artist, Kristen Schaefer. People wanted to vote on the Forest County Clerk position, but also wanted to vote for the United States Senator. The Forest County Clerk was on the Democratic Primary and the Republican Primary was the only contested race for United States Senator. In Forest County there were 728 people that voted in the Republican Primary. These people could not vote on any local elections, which makes the format for a primary election in Wisconsin unpopular.

Lisa Kalata defeated Ann Mihalko, 820 - 378. Lisa will take over as clerk on Tuesday January 2, 2013. The county was split between Merlin Van Buren and Roberta Retrum, 118 - 118, but the 34th Assembly District contains other counties and Merlin Van Buren was declared the winner. On the republican side, Rob Swearingen defeated Alex Young. Forest County voted in favor of Swearingen 91 - 52. Jeff Mursau will be the Republican candidate in the 36th Assembly District. State Senate District 12th had a Democratic Primary. Susan Sommer is the overall winner. Sommer won in Forest County 495 - 236. Sommer will run against Tom Tiffany for the 12 Senate District. The United States Senator had a contested race on the Republican ticket. Tommy Thompson, Eric Hoyde, Mark Neumann and Jeff Fitzgerald all ran to face Tammy Baldwin in November. Forest County voted Tommy Thompson 264, Mark Neumann 225, Eric Hovde 180 and Jeff Fitzgerald 59. The state voted in favor of Thompson and he will advance to the November election.

These were the contested primaries, there were seats that were unopposed and also seats that will be voted on again in November. Jeff Mursau will face Dorothy Kegley for the 36 Assembly District. Sean Duffy will run against Pat Kreitlow for the 7 Congressional District.

The other local primary races were unopposed. Chuck Simono will remain District Attorney with 783 votes, Amy T. Krause received 990 votes to remain County Treasurer and Paul Aschenbrenner totaled 946 votes and will continue to be Register of Deeds.







Wildfire Report

In the past week, 27 wildfires burned 61 acres in DNR protection areas around the state. The largest was a 35-acre fire in Oconto County, caused by debris burning. Lightning was the cause of an 11-acre fire in Monroe County's Mill Bluff State Park. The fire burned through a meadow and into oak and jack pine. Drought conditions and a burning six-inch layer of pine needles made it difficult to extinguish the blaze. Fire burned the west bluff of Devil's Lake State Park, an area difficult to access, in Sauk County. The fire remains under investigation. Emergency Burning Restrictions were lifted within DNR organized protection areas of in Crawford, Dane, Grant, Iowa, Sauk and Richland counties. Emergency Burning Restrictions remain in effect for 11 counties: Adams, Columbia, Green Lake, Jackson, Juneau, Marquette, Monroe, Portage, Waupaca, Waushara and Wood. 



VA Burial Benefit Update: The Department of (4)"Veterans organization" means a local unit of a member Veterans Affairs announced 1 AUG that it is moving forward with a plan to provide burial services for Veterans in rural areas where there are no available VA national cemeteries, state Veterans cemeteries or tribal Veterans cemeteries. "VA is committed to improving service to Veterans in rural areas," said Secretary of Veterans Affairs Eric K. Shinseki. "Through an innovative partnership with existing cemeteries, we will be able to ensure burial for Veterans in more locations that meet the high standards of national shrines." Under the Rural Initiative plan, VA will build small National Veterans Burial Grounds within existing public or private cemeteries in rural areas where the unserved Veteran population is 25,000 or less within a 75-mile radius. VA plans to open eight National Veterans Burial Grounds that will serve Veterans in the areas of Fargo, N.D.; Rhinelander, Wis.; Chevenne, Wyo.; Laurel, Mont.; Idaho Falls, Idaho; Cedar City, Utah; Calais, Maine; and Elko, Nev. VA officials will announce further details about the eight new burial grounds as information becomes available.

This new initiative will make VA burial options available to more than 136,000 Veterans and their eligible dependents.

A National Veterans Burial Ground will be a small, VA-managed section of three to five acres within an existing public or private cemetery. VA will provide a full range of burial options and control the operation and maintenance of these lots. These sections will be held to the same "national shrine" standards as VA-run national cemeteries. VA is still evaluating suitable sites for its Rural Initiative. In Laurel, Mont., VA is exploring with local officials the feasibility of acquiring a portion of the Yellowstone County Veterans Cemetery to establish as a National Veterans Burial Ground. VA operates 131 national cemeteries in 39 states and Puerto Rico and 33 soldiers' lots and monument sites. Nearly four million Americans, including Veterans of every war and conflict -- from the Revolutionary War to the current conflicts in Iraq and Afghanistan -- are buried in VA's national cemeteries on more than 19,000 acres.
