Crosscountry cyclist gives us an update on his trip

Last August we featured Gary Havas, a cyclist from California who made an overnight stop and a visit to the Hotel Crandon dining room and bar. We received the following email about the rest of his trin

From Crandon, WI, I headed through Star Lake and in a growing southerly loop, headed toward Osceola, WI and across the boarder into the land of Lake Wobegon. From there, I headed north to a semi-mountainous region and over to Pelican Rapids and north to Fargo, ND where I and my rig caught a bus to Billings. I was supposed to get further, but the next bus line in the progression refused to take the trike and I set out to Missoula, MT from Billings. Great trip with unexpected joys of folk and scenery. Mosty a beside-the-interstate route with some diversions into more interesting territory. Once in Missoula, I headed due West to Portland, OR and a visit with my brother there.

Friends and I met at the end of my sixth day there and we all headed out to the coast where two drove a van with food and fun and four others rode south to our homes on California's Central Coast. The folks in the van had to depart in Crescent City, CA and my buddy Michael and I completed the journey unsupported to San Luis Obispo.

Five months, one week. 60 to 80 miles a day with a few rest days. 15 folk who did not play well on the road leaving the VAST majority as social, fun, encouraging motorists and truck drivers, among others. A couple of spells of rain, not much wind, no illness until about five days from home when I got a headcold. About 25 flats, no breakdowns. Innumerable beers, cups of coffee, muffins. One country. Just one country. Well, not entirely. I had a few days with some very pleasant folk in Canada north of Lake Erie, and the US is a really one heck of a good place to visit.



OEF/OIF/OND Toxic Embedded Fragments

Some Veterans of Operation Enduring Freedom (OEF), Operation Iraqi Freedom (OIF), and Operation New Dawn (OND) have retained toxic embedded fragments in their bodies after blast injuries sustained during military service.

These Veterans may be eligible for clinical care at the Toxic Embedded Fragment Surveillance Center at the Baltimore VA Medical Center.

Shrapnel is a common term to describe the toxic fragments from improvised explosive devices (IEDs), bombs, mines and shells. Some of the fragments may contain depleted uranium.

Health problems associated with toxic embedded fragments

Although health problems caused by toxic embedded fragments are not fully understood, generally fragments are harmful in two ways:

1. Injury at the site of the fragment

2. Chemicals from the fragment that travel through the bloodstream and can affect other parts of the body

Health concerns?

If you are concerned about toxic embedded fragments from injuries in military service, talk to your health care provider or local VA Environmental Health Coordinator.

Veterans not enrolled in the VA health care system, find out if you qualify for VA health care.

ALL returning Veterans must enroll in health care coverage at the nearest VA Medical Center to protect their right to health care. Your local Veterans Service Officer will assist you.

VA benefits

Veterans may be eligible for VA disability compensation benefits and health care benefits for health problems associated with toxic embedded fragments from injuries in military service.

OEF, OIF, and OND Veterans with embedded fragments may be eligible for clinical care at the Toxic Embedded Fragment Surveillance Center at the Baltimore VA Medical Center.

Veterans' dependents and survivors also may be eligible for benefits. Read Federal Benefits for Veterans, Dependents and Survivors to learn more, or see your County Veterans Service Officer for a copy of the handbook. 

Questionable Robocalls Targeting Wisconsin Seniors

MADISON - Callers representing themselves as "Senior Emergency Care", "Senior Safety Alert", and "Senior Safe Alert" have recently pounded Wisconsin homes with prerecorded telephone calls pitching personal emergency alert systems. The Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP) asks Wisconsin residents to hang up on these harassing calls.

These groups are not registered telemarketers in Wisconsin. The calls show on caller ID units as having a 262 or 608 area code, but the numbers might be spoofed or misrepresented. DATCP has received a number of complaints against these three groups, with most of the complaints coming from the Madison, Milwaukee and Fox Valley areas.

These groups may be trying to sell a questionable product that is tied to a recurring fee. The calls seem to be following the pattern of similar robocall scenarios targeting seniors around the country. In those instances, the recordings have claimed that their product is free - but the company charges consumer around \$30 per month for service.

Unfortunately, it is also possible that these calls are "phishing" scams seeking credit card numbers and any other personal information that they can get from the call recipients. Again, your best defense is to simply hang up the phone.

donation by the Sugarbush Snowmowheelers Snowmobile Club. "This generous donation has purchased 8,000 snowmobile trail maps," stated Forest County Snowmobile Council President, Jack Kloss, "We really appreciate the Snowmowheelers support to provide maps to all five snowmobile clubs and snowmobilers in our area." Please support the Sugarbush Snowmowheelers efforts and enjoy a day of fun by participating in the annual Poker Run that is scheduled for the first Saturday in February.

Please remember that the Nicolet State Trail and the Wolf River State Trail are the only snowmobile "trails" in Forest County that are currently open for winter ATV use. ATV "routes" on gravel or blacktop town roads will also remain open to ATV use.

The Forest County Snowmobile Trail Ordinance currently prohibits ATV use and motor vehicle use on all other snowmobile trails in Forest County. Forest County ordinance prohibits the use of any licensed car or truck on any snowmobile trail.

If you encounter trucks or vehicles on snowmobile trails this winter please report their license number immediately to 911 or the Sheriff's Dept. at 715-478-3331 or County Forestry Department at 715-478-3475. Updated trail condition reports can be found daily by calling the Forest County Snowline at 715-478-2040 or logging onto the Forest County website at www.forestcountywi.com. This website also provides links to local snowmobile clubs that provide daily grooming reports and maps of the Forest County trail system.






Mccaslin Lions host annual Childrens Christmas Party




