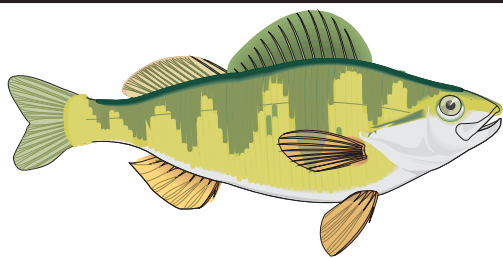

Red Arrow to hold 38th Annual Fish A Ree/Vintage Snowmobile Show

Red Arrow Snowmobile ATV Club of Townsend will host its 38th Annual Fish A Ree & Vintage Snowmobile Show on the weekend before Valentine's Day. The dates are Saturday February 9th & Sunday the 10th. The event will be held at the Townsend Town Hall in Townsend. The hall will be heated allowing those in "street clothes" to attend. Event hours will be from 11:00 a.m. till 6:00 p.m. Saturday and 12 Noon to 5:00 p.m. on Sunday. All funds raised are used to maintain and better the snowmobile and ATV trails in the Townsend area. The Fish A Ree will kick off a year-long 45th Anniversary Celebration for Red Arrow which formed in January of 1968.

This is a family fun event...come by sled, car, truck or van. The event is open to the public and features DJ Music, Food, Games and Meat Raffles. The "main prize" drawing will be held at about 4:30 PM on Sunday at the event. Prizes include a 50" Digital Flat Screen TV from Forest TV/Red Arrow, a "Cabin in the woods" lap quilt handmade by club member Carol Renteria, a Weatherby 12 gauge pump shotgun partially donated by Pintsch's Hardware, Two each \$50.00 gift certificates donated by Mikes Supermarket, Lakewood Super Valu and Sunset Resort along with a \$250.00 and four \$50.00 gas cards partially donated by Townsend Shell. A \$25.00 cash prize will be awarded Saturday for the largest (by weight) Northern, Walleye, Bass and Panfish. Fish can be caught at any area lake and must be freshly caught the day of the event. A \$10.00 pack of three raffle tickets per angler is the entry fee. Fish may not be returned to the water after being brought to the event. Fish will be registered from Noon until 3:00 p.m. Saturday at the Townsend Town Hall. No late registrations will be allowed and the 3PM deadline will be strictly enforced. Prizes will be awarded around 5:00 p.m. Saturday. There will be a "2nd Chance" drawing for all fish registered.. the prize will be the same \$25.00 award per species so make sure to register all your fish no matter what size. One 2nd chance entry per angler please. Note: The fishing contest was reduced to Saturday only this year due to the drawdown of the two flowages in Townsend.

Vintage snowmobile owners are encouraged to bring their sleds to the event for display or for sale. There is no fee for showing or selling your sled...simply bring it to the event and enjoy the day. This is not a trophy show...just fun in the snow with machines from a by-gone era.

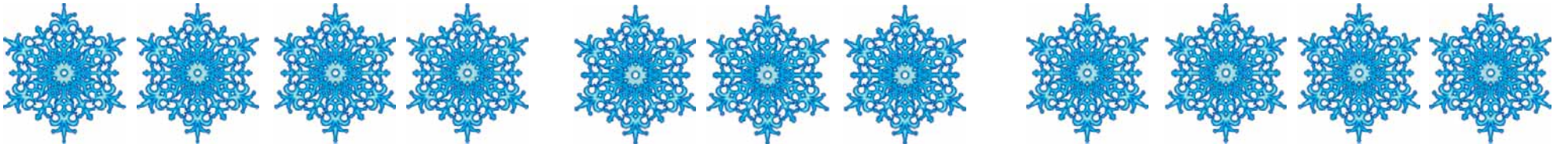

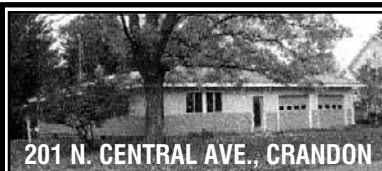

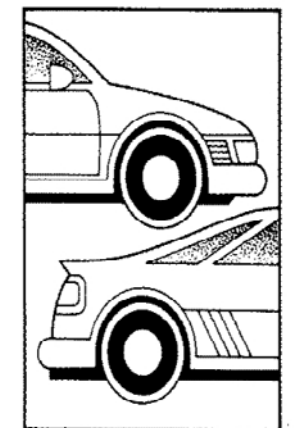

Fettuccini & Ham

- 8 ounces uncooked fettuccine noodles
- 2 cups ham, cut into cubes
- 1 cup frozen peas
- 1 cup skim or 1% milk
- 1/2 cup grated parmesan cheese

- Salt and pepper to taste

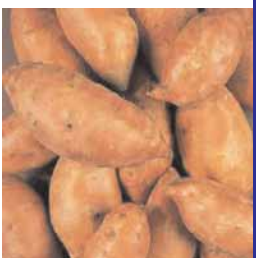

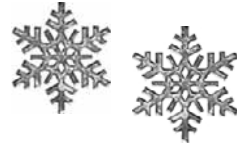

Although on-line application is strongly recommended, paper applications may be obtained from the Department of Public Instruction or any public school district. Paper applications must be delivered (hand delivery is recommended) to the non-resident school district during the application period.

Wisconsin's inter-district public school open enrollment program, often referred to as school choice, allows parents to apply for their children to attend school districts other than the one in which they live. Parents must apply to the nonresident school district they would like to have their child/children attend.
