Rosa sweeps the recall election with a vote margin of 2 to 1

The first recall election for mayor in the City of Crandon is over, and the people have made their decision. Incumbent Rob Jaeger lost the recall by a vote of 378 for Dennis Rosa to 184 for the incumbent, a margin of about two to one.

There were 565 votes cast in the election, with three people who registered and voted for neither. The recall election for Governor Walker actually generated more votes in the city than this recall, with a total of 603 votes registered.

Jaeger ran against incumbent Gary Bradley in the 2011 election, carrying the contest by a vote of 283 to 241. In the next election, Jaeger ran unopposed and received 132 of 150 votes.

For those who oppose recalls, you are disagreeing with the founding fathers, who thought that the people should be able to recall any elected official that they thought wasn't performing to their standards.

Crandon has a fresh political start, and life goes on whoever is elected. We wish the new Mayor Rosa a successful tenure in office.

Combined meeting of the ORV Oversight Committee and County Forestry Committee

On Monday, July 28, there was a joint meeting of the Forest County ORV Oversight Committee and Forestry and Recreation Committee. They discussed the proposed ORV park. The meeting was chaired by Mike Albrecht, chair of the oversight committee. Present to talk in support of the park was John Schnorr, with the Wisconsin Off-Highway Vehicle Association (WHOVA) and WORVPI, along with Chuck Bryce, a business consultant with UW Extension, based in Green Bay. Bryce was called in to help sell this project by the Forest County Economic Development Corporation.

Bryce talked of the project as being good for the county. He said they looked at the Ripon College study and took a more conservative view of the customer count and the income from the park. He said that he thought the

One more mission!

On July 17, 2014, nearly 70 years to the date after his first mission on November 5, 1944, when as a 21 year old B-17 pilot he targeted an oil refinery in Vienna, Austria, now 91 year old Steve Conway Jr., 1st Lieutenant US Army Air Corp, was invited to once again take a flight in the renowned "Flying Fortress." This time it would be a ride in peace, with his son Steve Conway III sitting at his side. There was no concern of flak, no 5,000-6,000 pound bomb load with a destination for destruction, no fifty-caliber machine guns, 13 total, each loaded "nine yards long" with ammunition, and it wasn't a flight at just over 30,000 feet with air temperatures at -40 to sometimes -60 below in an un-pressurized plane that required oxygen masks. This time there was not a crew of ten, that as a pilot one took the responsibility for bringing home safely, but instead ten passengers looking forward to the flight of a lifetime. They were with fellow family, friends and citizens flying at a mere few thousand feet on a sunny, 70 degree day in casual attire. Although a young 21 one year old could gracefully pull himself into one of two very small entrances, this time the greatest challenge to overcome for this mission was to comfortably seat a 91 year old former

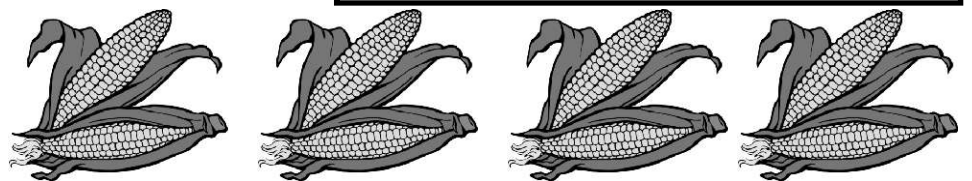

As the door was closed and today's B-17 civilian pilots received the all clear, each of the 1,200 horsepower Wright Cyclone's fired up one after another, with the familiar burst of smoke from the exhaust immediately upon ignition. Upon taxiing out for his flight, Steve turned to his son referencing the sound of the brakes squealing saying, "They all did that" as a flood of emotion overcame the man who as a 21 and 22 year old flew into the unknown 42 different times, thankfully returning each time. Many before and after him were not so fortunate. On this summer day, with several of his children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren in attendance, Steve and his youngest son took to the air one more time in the mighty plane that he flew out of Foggia, Italy. As part of the 15th Air Force 463rd Bomb Group, at that time he was destined to bomb oil refineries, tank manufacturing and ball-bearing plants and other similar targets. On this sunny July day, the highlighted target of the flight was a flyover of Lambeau Field where the only things dropped were the wishes for another winning season from the many Packer fans on the flight that day.

As the flight returned to the Austin Straubel International Airport, those in attendance, especially Steve's family members, couldn't help but become overcome with emotion as their father, grandfather and great-grandfather once again returned safely from another mission. This time the plane returned with all four engines running, looking as good as it did when it taxied to the runway about 30 minutes earlier. We can't begin to understand the sights and sounds of a World War II airfield as the crews on the ground stood by, anxiously counting planes as they returned. They wondered how many would not return as their crews joined the ranks of those heroes who "gave all" and which planes would have wounded to tend to and fires to extinguish from a crash landing. Fortunately, this last mission was unlike some of Steve's previous missions. Steve once came back with 206 separate flak holes, no rear tail wheel and the left landing gear damaged with a flat tire. He brought the plane back and landed it on one wheel, keeping the opposite wing up until the transition from air speed to ground speed at 70 mph no longer provided the necessary lift to keep the large wing with its two engines up and it came to a skidding halt just off the runway. Another flight, just prior to the war's end, saw Steve earn the Distinguished Flying Cross for his efforts to stay in formation while having to continue to climb after having lost one engine shortly after take-off. He managed to use maximum power on the other three engines for the duration of the flight to the target. Upon returning on three engines the mechanics said that all three engines were junked because of the excessive strain put on the motors and that they would have to be replaced. For his efforts to maintain formation and complete the mission, Steve was recognized for "outstanding piloting and skill by being able to stay with the formation and complete the mission." It was recognized that this was accomplished under flak that was heavier than usual. Staying with the formation and fighter escort was safer than turning back alone without an escort. Upon conclusion of the war, and flying 31 missions over the target, Steve had also earned an additional three air medals for other efforts of valor for completion of the mission and safely returning to the airfield in Foggia.

Just as these mighty planes fly alone now, instead of by the hundreds in formation, often we see our veterans alone or in a small group at a local parade. Our World War II veterans and those of all other wars, like the Korean War and Vietnam War are passing daily by the hundreds. They are the heroes who served their country. They served, as does our current military each day, so we can all have the freedoms bestowed upon us by their efforts and the efforts of the many veterans before them who have made us the great country we are. Be sure to give thanks to a veteran or current service member when the opportunity presents itself. It's the least we can do for their service that has helped guarantee our freedoms.

It was a true honor to be a part of my grandfather, Steve Conway Jr.'s, special day. To witness my hero take flight in the plane he piloted in World War II will be a memory I'll treasure always - Ben Niehaus

pilot who flew 42 missions, 31 over the target, into a rear passenger seat of a plane that he surely wanted to fly upfront, preferably from his familiar right hand seat. (The pilot typically sat to the left, but Steve often took new crews up on their first mission as he had successfully returned from so many previous flights. This resulted in the need to leave that particular crew's co-pilot on the ground. Wanting the new pilot to sit left, Steve ended up so often piloting from the right that he became more comfortable flying the plane from that side.)

Steve was invited on this honorary flight by Jet Air CEO Al Timmerman. For several days in mid-July, his hangar was responsible for the care of one of only a dozen still airworthy B-17's in the world. The B-17, Aluminum Overcast, which is owned and operated by the EAA in Oshkosh, was visiting Green Bay for tours and flights through the weekend. The day before the plane was opened to the public for viewing and flights, VIP's and the press were invited by CEO Timmerman for a special visit to the plane. Steve was one of two combat veteran airmen in attendance, the other being a B17 bombardier who is the grandfather of Green Bay Packer Head Coach Mike McCarthy's wife. There were two flights that day, with Steve and his son scheduled for the second flight of the day. Prior to boarding the plane for his flight, Coach McCarthy had the opportunity to meet Steve and talk about some of his combat experiences. After exiting from his flight, Coach McCarthy returned to Steve's side for one more picture with a veteran who piloted one of the mighty planes that ultimately saw the United States and its allies prevail over the tyranny of Adolf Hitler's Third Reich and the Empire of Japan.

maximum revenue from the park for a three year period would be \$2,906,000. He also said that the park could possibly be financed by state stewardship grants, a \$500,000 DNR project loan and a \$700,000 loan from the Board of Commissioners of Public Lands (BCPL). Bryce estimated the debt service to the county on the BCPL loan would be about \$73,000 per year, hopefully paid for by the customers at the park. He thinks it is worth consideration by the county.

A question brought out at the meeting was whether or not stewardship funding would apply to a project such as this. Also at question is whether or not county land would still qualify as county forest if used for an off-road park. Both of these questions are probably not answerable unless there are applications made at the state level.

Craig Williams, local DNR forester, explained the process to apply for purchase of lands using DNR project loans and stewardship grants to cover half of the loans, with the county liable for the other half, but paid for by 20% of the gross stumpage revenue from county timber bids. As he explained, it is a long drawn out process, with other counties also applying for the same funding. There are two elimination rounds that a potential purchase has to go through before there is a green light for the loan and the grant. Williams said that from what he could understand, there is no plan.

Schnorr said that this meeting was just a get together to decide to go ahead, and a plan would be drafted.

One of the questions discussed was whether or not it was legal to use county forest lands for vehicular traffic. This was brought out by County Forester Ziolkowski. The answer was that this still had to be determined.

Supervisor Lemaster asked why there would be a \$700,000 loan to the taxpayers when Chairman Millan said there would be no cost to the taxpayers

Millan said that this was a loan and the money generated by the park would pay it back.

Lemaster said that if the county would borrow this much money, shouldn't there be a referendum? He also pointed out that there was little available timber for any logging sales for a long time, and that land bought with stewardship funds couldn't be sold to recover costs.

Williams said that any timber sales would have to be approved, meaning that a heavy cut to recover costs would probably not be possible. He also said that he thinks that the property, the site on County G, had been heavily logged for at least five years. Williams broke down the 2,000 acre property, just roughly, as containing 15% northern hardwoods, 21% red pine, 27% aspen, 4% a red pine clear cut (maybe planted again), 20% non-productive (rivers, marsh, etc.) and another 10% as questionable wetlands. He compared this with recent county land purchases that have only 5% non-productive land that are 73% hardwoods and 17% aspen. He noted the difference in timber quality.

Supervisor Connor asked Schnorr if the county would be doing the negotiating the land, and Schnorr said they didn't have a realtor at present. Lemaster pointed out that negotiations have to be started at appraisal prices, and Ziolkowski backed this up.

Ziolkowski said with stewardship money there is less risk to the taxpayer, but with stewardship comes a "wheelbarrow full of restrictions." Ziolkowski suggested a different type of financing.

Williams added that the state Department of Forestry always has to look at projects like this, and said that it looks like it will be a long time before the "ball gets rolling." He also said that the forestry committee would have to deal with this, but they don't have the information to proceed. Until then, the answer is that it doesn't fit under the county forest program.

Albrecht suggested that the negotiations move to the forestry committee from this point on.

Ziolkowski pointed out the extended time factor might be a year and a half, and that would just be to amend the county plan to match this type of project, and that in the meantime, they had some very good properties on the table to look at.

Williams said that the county had been very successful purchasing property, with their ducks in a row, and it still took a year, and pointed out that the last letter from the DNR (Moroni) brought out many problems.

Albrecht said that whatever it took, it would have to take that long.

Ziolkowski pointed out again that they can't make a plan without details and knowing what recreation will take place. Williams backed him up. He also said that his office has a full plate right now.

It was decided that members of the committee will have to see the land as well, and talk of tours on the property for board members was discussed.

Williams once again went through the criteria necessary to compete step by step for stewardship funding. A no at any step can stop the project or involve a change in plans. Williams said that the first job of the county forest plan is timber production. There are no guarantees, and there should be an alternate plan.

While there were many discussions on various facets of the ORV park, one of the foremost accomplishments of this get together was to establish that WORVPI will have to work with Dave Ziolkowski and the forestry committee to set up a memorandum of understanding to start any work that would lead to loans and stewardship grants, as well as interest-bearing loans from the BCPL.

And the project goes on!

Easy Homemade Mosquito Trap

Modern technology has brought us many benefits, including mosquito traps that cost a lot of money, but sometimes we overlook simple solutions to difficult challenges such as mosquito control. When it comes to controlling pests, research tends to focus on chemicals or concepts that can be patented. Unless someone can make a profit from an idea, the public may never become aware of it.

Homemade Mosquito Trap:

Items needed:

- 200 ml water
- 50 grams of brown sugar
- 1 gram of yeast
- 2 liter-plastic bottle

Or US conversion:

- 1 cup of water
- 1/4 cup of brown sugar

How:

1. Cut the plastic bottle in half.
2. Mix brown sugar with hot water. Let cool. When cold, pour in the bottom half of the bottle.
3. Add the yeast. No need to mix. It creates carbon dioxide, which attracts mosquitoes.
4. Place the funnel part, upside down, into the other half of the bottle, taping them together if desired.
5. Wrap the bottle with something black, leaving the top uncovered, and place it outside in an area away from your normal gathering area. (Mosquitoes are also drawn to the color black.)

Change the solution every 2 weeks for continuous control.


