Super Challenge Off-Road Race Weekend at the Crandon International Raceway June 6 & 7



The Crandon International Off-Road Raceway will be the place to go for off-road enthusiasts on June 6 and 7, when the Londerville Steel Super Challenge Off-Road Race Weekend will be held

The recently constructed and improved off-road course will be put to use by off-roaders who will test their driving skills in a number of events.

Included in the venue are the West Michigan Mud Runs, 4x4 and UTV Racing, and ten classes of Sportsman Only Weekend Racing on the short course.

The West Michigan Mud Run has a \$10,000 Saturday payout, UTVs will race for a \$5,000 plus purse, and the 4x4 Racing has a \$10,000 purse.

Drivers from across the U.S. will be racing UTVs, and there will be vehicles competing that are capable of 190 miles per hour in 180 feet!

The gates will be open at 9:00 a.m., and off-road and mud racing fans should be in for a treat.

Phone scam working the area

Another telephone scam is making its way again in the local area. There are actually two versions of the scam. The caller either claims to be a grandchild of the person being called, or that they are calling on behalf of a grandchild. In both cases, the caller will advise that the grandchild is currently in jail and needs bail money in order to be released from jail. The caller will then specify an amount of money that needs to be sent, and where and how it must be sent.

DO NOT send money to an unknown phone solicitor, nor release any personal information to an unexpected caller. If you do receive one of these calls, contact your local law enforcement agency and report it. If money has already been sent, there is little that can be done to recover it, as the perpetrators of these scams are usually located outside of the United States.

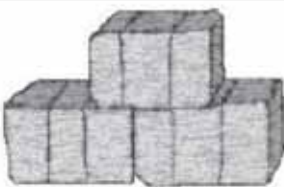

Pick Better...Potassium Rich Foods

A high-potassium diet is good for your heart. In fact, the more potassium in your diet, the better your whole diet tends to be. That is why the 2010 Dietary Guidelines for Americans emphasize potassium-rich foods. Studies have found that an average increase of three, high-potassium foods a day is linked to a 21 percent reduction in the risk of stroke. The daily recommendation for potassium is 4,700 milligrams of potassium. Most Americans get half that much.

Vegetables, fruits and beans are rich in potassium. Dairy products, fish and nuts are also good sources. Natural forms of these potassium-rich foods are low in sodium - an added bonus! People who have impaired kidney function or are taking certain medications will want to discuss with their health care provider the amount of potassium that is recommended for them. These individuals should not take potassium supplements or use high-potassium salt substitutes, unless recommended by health care providers.

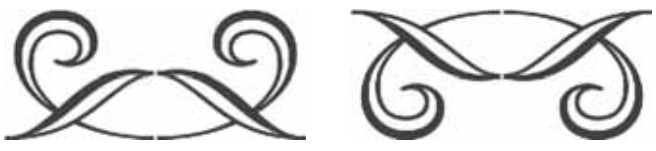
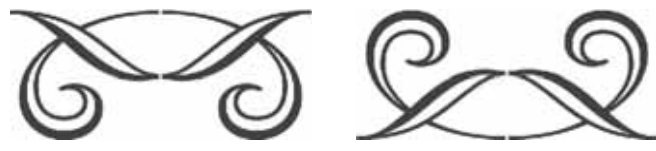
