Blues legend John Primer to perform at Nicolet College July 21



A pillar of the Chicago blues scene and one its chief architects, legendary bluesman John Primer will bring his amazing talents to Nicolet College for a special performance at 7:30 p.m., Friday, July 21.

The Rolling Stones, Muddy Waters, Buddy Guy and Magic Slim are just a few of the music icons Primer has performed and recorded with over the years.

"When we first heard we had the chance to book John Primer, we jumped at it immediately," said Nicolet College Theatre Director Jim Nuttall. "The guy is a living legend in the music industry, especially the blues, and is sure to put on a show unlike any other we have seen in the Nicolet Theatre."

Primer is regarded as one of music's top guitar players and also recognized as a masterful songwriter and singer, earning two Grammy Award nominations, a Lifetime Achievement Award, and a pile of other accolades.

Moving from Mississippi to Chicago as a young man in 1963, he gravitated to the Windy City's blues scene. In 1974, he began leading the house band at the famous Theresa's Lounge, a mainstay on the Chicago blues scene and a regular hangout for top musicians when they were passing through town.

In 1979, the established blues legend Willie Dixon persuaded Primer to join his band the Chicago Blues All Stars, which set off on years of touring across the U.S., Europe, and Mexico.

During this time, fellow Mississippian Muddy Waters heard Primer play and recruited him to not only join his band but also serve as bandleader, a gig he held until Waters death in 1983.

He then hooked up with Magic Slim and the Teardrops, playing and touring for the next 14 years with the band lauded by many at the time as the best blues band in the world.

In the mid-1990s Primer struck out on his own, continuing to tour and producing more than a dozen albums, the latest in 2016 with John Primer & The Real Deal Bluesband Live.

Over his life, he's played on an astounding 68 different albums and also performed with Eddie Vedder and Pearl Jam, James Brown, B.B. King, Ray Charles,

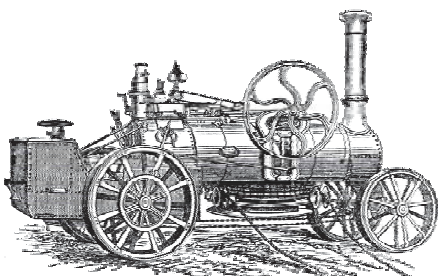

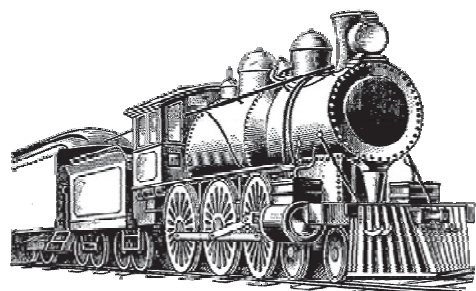

Starting April 22, 2017, some FoodShare applicants will have the option to fast-track their applications. If an applicant meets certain income, asset, and other financial requirements, they may be eligible to receive their FoodShare benefits within one week of filing their application.

If an applicant applies for FoodShare online using ACCESS.wisconsin.gov, they will see a page titled "Getting Faster Service for FoodShare." When filling out the information on this page, the applicant should make sure not to leave any sections blank. If the answer to any question about monthly income, assets or housing and utility expenses is \$0, the applicant needs to type "\$0." A banner message will appear to remind applicants to make sure each section is complete. Even though an application with blank sections may still be eligible for expedited benefits when processed, making sure each section is completed with a number figure will ensure benefits are received within seven days.

**Stay safe with a personal protection class
at Nicolet College in July, August**

Personal safety will be at the center of two classes Nicolet College will offer multiple times in July and August.

One class is a two-hour overview on how to stay safe and defend yourself. The second is a more in depth, four-hour class that will cover the same topics and feature additional demonstrations and hands-on activities.

"While physical confrontations are rare, they do happen," said Tim Gerdman, Criminal Justice Services specialist at Nicolet.

"In both classes participants will learn proven techniques to first avoid an assault and, secondly, what actions to take if a situation does escalate into an actual attack."

The two-hour College Safety Academy will teach participants how to:

- identify and avoid potentially dangerous situations.
- use verbal skills to deescalate a confrontation or dangerous situation.
- use pepper spray.
- physically escape an attacker.

The academy will be held from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. and repeated 7:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. on Wednesdays July 19, 26, Aug. 2, 9, and 16 in Birchwoods Center 116 on the Nicolet Campus. Cost is \$30.

The four-hour Personal Safety Academy will cover all of the topics above and include more hands-on activities to practice what's presented during the lecture portion of the academy.

This academy will be held Saturdays 8 a.m. to noon and repeated 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. July 22, 29, August 5, 12, and 19 in Birchwoods Center 105 on the Nicolet Campus. Cost is \$50.

The practice pepper spray canisters students will use in both academies will contain water and not any actual active pepper spray.

Both courses are open to anyone age 14 or older. For the two-hour College Safety Academy, participants age 14 to 17 will need a permission and waiver form signed by a parent or legal guardian.

For the four-hour Personal Safety Academy, 14- to 17-year-olds will need a parent or legal guardian to attend the class with them.

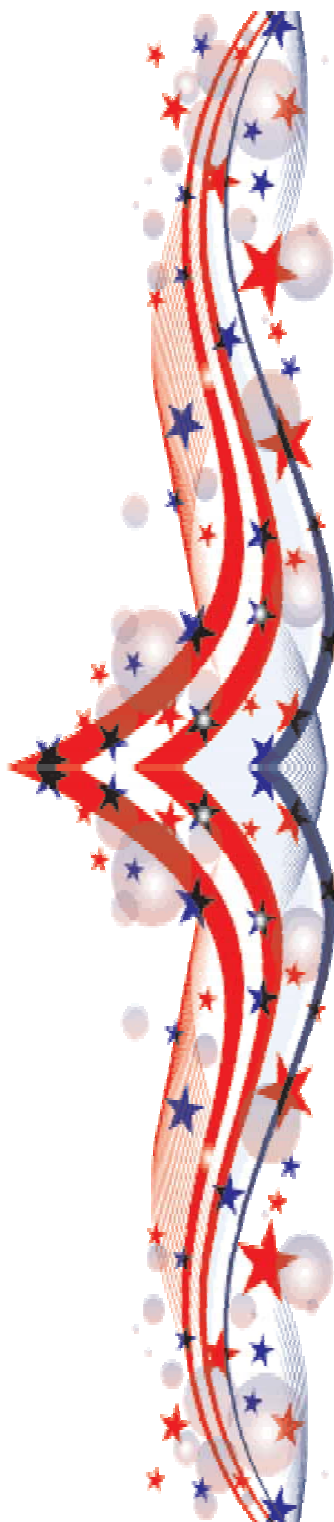
