Being Anti-Ageist Can Extend Your Life Expectancy

Prejudice or discrimination of a person based on his or her age, also known as agism, is deeply ingrained in our culture. There is oftentimes a fear of getting older. It is easy to find things making fun of aging, such as birthday cards and over-the-hill decorations. Our society's obsession with youth can be found in the media where young people are used in advertising and marketing of travel and cars, despite the fact that older adults travel and purchase cars more often than younger people.

Even public spaces can inadvertently discriminate against older people. For example, loud or dimly lit restaurants can be difficult for older people to visit. Places without handrails can be challenging for older people to visit as well.

Those who embrace aging with a "yes, I can!" attitude are more likely to have better brain performance and memory, have a greater sense of control over their lives, are less likely to have a hearing decline, and are more likely to get preventive care. People with a positive perception on aging are also 44% more likely to recover from disabilities.

It is possible to be unaware of your ageist statements. Saying things like, "wow, she looks good for her age" is ageist because it gives the impression that being older is a bad thing. It is beneficial to all to call out ageism like this when we see it. harvested 93.1 MMBF of timber valued at \$7.48 million.

Currently, there are seven timber sales available for bidding with various bid due dates. For a list of sales and to learn more about the Forest's timber sale program please visit <https://go.usa.gov/xPVXS>.

The continual increase in timber sales on the Chequamegon-Nicolet provides more wood to Wisconsin's important forest products industry, while creating and maintaining healthy forest conditions prescribed in the Forest's 2004 Land and Resource Management Plan (LRMP).

Of the more than 860,000 acres of land suitable for commercial timber harvest on the National Forest, 13,943 acres experienced a harvest in 2018. The remaining portion of the 1.5 million acres of the Forest is considered unsuitable because of wetlands, steep slopes, Wilderness or recreation designations or ecological/research areas.

Timber purchasers typically have two to three years to complete harvest operations after purchasing a sale. As of July 2018, the Forest currently has approximately 27,000 acres under timber sale contract that are available for harvesting.

Forest Service staff continue to work diligently to diversify the age class structure and tree species composition through Forest management activities to meet the goals and objectives in the 2004 LRMP.

"We recognize that we have work to do," said Strong. "We have been making great strides in managing our Forest and plan to continue that progress."

Bring home a Holiday tree from the Chequamegon-Nicolet National Forest
Free permits to fourth graders with Every Kid in a Park pass

Rhineland, Wis. (November 19, 2018) Start your holiday season with a fresh-cut, personally selected Christmas tree from the Chequamegon-Nicolet National Forest.

Holiday tree permits can be purchased at any Chequamegon-Nicolet National Forest offices except the Northern Great Lakes Visitor Center. Permits are \$5 per tree, with a maximum of five permits per household. Permits and maps may also be obtained by mail, however please allow for travel time through the mail.

Fourth-graders are eligible for a free Christmas tree permit through the Every Kid in a Park initiative. In order for students to receive a free tree permit, they must present a valid voucher printed from the Every Kid in a Park website.

Every Kid in a Park Tree Permit:

1. Visit www.everykidinapark.gov and follow instructions to obtain the paper voucher.
2. Print out the voucher.
3. Bring the paper voucher to a U.S. Forest Service office near you to claim the free permit.

Every Kid in a Park is a national effort that encourages children to visit national parks, forests, public lands and waters. Fourth-graders represent the nation's next generation of outdoor stewards of our country's spectacular and diverse federal lands and waters. The Forest Service encourages fourth-graders and their families to take part in winter recreation on national forests, including harvesting a Christmas tree with their family.

businesses in Forest County rely on winter for over 50% of their income which comes over a 2-3 month season. Winter is important to Forest County and we welcome all the winter enthusiast.

A lot of the efforts of this office are spent in identifying and beginning control of invasive species that are located in the County. Forest County does have issues with invasive species in certain locations and our lakes and forest seem to be under attack by various species both aquatic species (water species) and terrestrial species (land species)

Species such as the Eurasian Water Milfoil, Zebra Mussel and the Spiny Water Flea have only begun their attack on Forest County Lakes. These species are often transferred from site to site by water in bait buckets. To protect the lakes and streams of Forest County, please buy bait locally and retain all water in your bait buckets, do not empty them on the ice or in the water.

Although not usually in the spotlight at this time of the year, we must also be careful of the equipment that we use. Loggers and contractors know this well and are required to address the issue before moving to a new area. Often times snowmobiles, ATVs and sleds utilized to carry winter equipment are pulled and operated through all kinds of "weeds" and dry vegetation. This dry vegetation usually has ripe seeds that are ready to fall, when they fall on equipment, they can be spread over long distances by trailer or vehicle. Once brought to a new area with frozen snow or ice, the seeds can travel a long way with the wind moving them.

Of a particular concern to Forest County is a species called phragmites. Phragmites is a large grass that overtakes areas, especially on wetter ground and in wetlands. Most have seen phragmites lining the ditches along Hwy 141 near Green Bay. Phragmites is very common in counties to the south and east, including Marinette, Oconto, Brown and Outagamie to name a few. Forest County has the advantage in that this species has only been located and controlled in a very few locations. Once phragmites is established it spreads rapidly and is very costly to control.

Many other species of invasive plants can also be transported by seed. To protect the forest and wetlands of Forest County, please clean your recreational equipment by washing it or blowing it free of debris using an air compressor before you travel long distances. This will limit the transfer of invasive species seeds that could cause a new infestation, wherever you may go.

Hopefully you have had a good Thanksgiving, deer season and fall, welcome to winter!

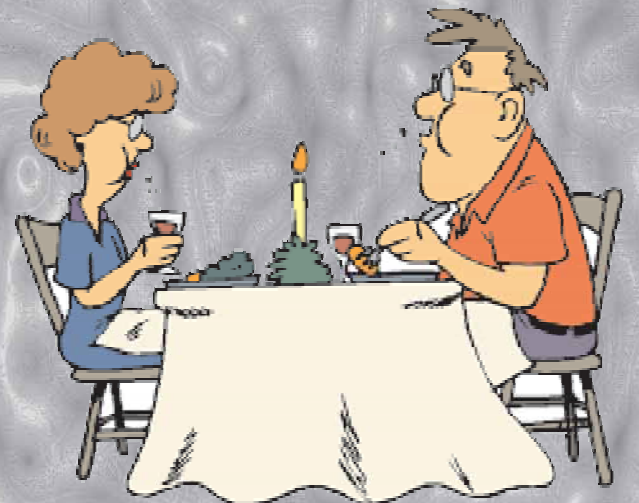
